



Glynn and Mildred Carpenter Scholarship Eligibility Instructions

Fall 2022 General Education
\$1,000 Scholarship

Purpose: To be paid for tuition and/or fees to any university, college or technical school of higher learning for a student enrolling as a full-time student.

Eligibility: Applicant must be a graduate of any public or private high school in the counties of Woodruff, Cross, Monroe, St. Francis, Lee or Phillips or in the town of Des Arc; or be a graduate of home schooling while residing in a household of a Woodruff Electric member. Applicant must also be the child, grandchild or dependent of a Woodruff Electric member.

The entire application must be completed in full and received with the appropriate materials in advance of the application deadline. Only paper copies will be accepted and must be received by mail or hand delivered to Woodruff Electric at 3201 Hwy 1 North in Forrest City or by mail to P.O. Box 1619, Forrest City, AR 72336.

Please submit application and supporting materials on unfolded paper, printed only on one side.

Selection will be made on the basis of: GPA, Transcript, Class ranking, ACT/SAT score, Extracurricular Activities, Community Services, Leadership, Honors received, Financial need, Application statement, and letter of recommendation.

Application deadline is 5 p.m. on March 21, 2022.

Note: Family members of Woodruff Electric employees and directors are not eligible for this scholarship.
