SURGE PROTECTION INFORMATION



SURGE PROTECTION

Keep your electronic equipment safe.

A power surge is typically caused by lightning, changes in electrical loads or faulty wiring.

Install power strips with surge protection to protect sensitive equipment.

- Easy to use (just plug them in).
- Protect electronics plugged into a device.
- Must be replaced over time or after a major surge event.

(!) REMEMBER: Not all power strips offer surge protection. Carefully read the packaging labels when purchasing.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY TIP OF THE MONTH

When was your cooling system last serviced? Most manufacturers recommend an annual tune up for your home's cooling system. March is a great time to schedule this service so you can beat the summer rush when the pros are the busiest. A qualified professional can check the amount of refrigerant, accuracy of the thermostat, condition of belts and motors and other factors that can greatly impact the efficiency of your system.
