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Clinical Description

Clinical Objectives

- A. Assist in the provision of patient-centered care of children from diverse backgrounds utilizing evidence-based practice and informatics to support clinical decision making.
 1. Patient-centered care
 - a. Perform a focused assessment on children in the clinical setting.
 - b. Use verbal and nonverbal communication that promotes caring, therapeutic relationships with children and their families.
- B. Participate as members of the healthcare team and identify opportunities for continuity of patient care and quality improvement.
 2. Teamwork and Collaboration
 - a. Participate as a member of the healthcare team in the provision of patient-centered care.
- C. Observe physiological and psychosocial principles to provide safe nursing care while utilizing the nursing process.
 3. Safety
 - a. Implement actions that promote safe practice and a safe environment for patients, self, and others.
- D. Demonstrate professionalism consistent with legal and ethical standards that promote the profession of nursing.
 4. Professionalism
 - a. Practice nursing in accordance with the standards of practice and healthcare facility policies and procedures.
