Strong's 4951 MISRAH, mis-raw; from 8280; empire: - government

## **Peace**

**Strong's 7965 SHALOM**, *shaw-lome'; from 7999;* safe (in mind, body or estate);, *welfare*, i.e. health, prosperity, favour, (good) health, (perfect, such as be at) peace, (make) prosper (-ity, -ous), rest, restore, reward, welfare, (all is, be) well, wholly.

**Isaiah 43** <sup>19</sup> "Behold, I will do something new, Now it will spring forth; Will you not be aware of it? I will even make a roadway in the wilderness, Rivers in the desert. NASU

Matthew 9 <sup>29</sup> Then He touched their eyes, saying, "<u>It shall be done to you according to your faith</u>." NASU

Numbers 14 <sup>28</sup> "Say to them, 'As I live,' says the Lord, <u>'just as you have spoken in My hearing</u>, <u>so I will surely do to you</u>; NASU

**Psalm 34** <sup>17</sup> The righteous cry, and the Lord hears And delivers them out of all their troubles. <sup>19</sup> Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all. \*NASU\* 17 Yet when holy lovers of God cry out to him with all their hearts, the Lord will hear them and come to rescue them from all their troubles. <sup>19</sup> **Even when bad things happen to the good and godly ones**, **the Lord will save them and not let them be defeated by what they face**. TPT

Psalm 103 <sup>1</sup> Bless the Lord, O my soul, And all that is within me, bless His holy name. <sup>2</sup> Bless the Lord, O my soul, And <u>forget none of His benefits</u>; <sup>3</sup> <u>Who pardons all your iniquities</u>, <u>Who heals all your diseases</u>; <sup>4</sup> Who redeems your life from the pit, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion; <sup>20</sup> <u>Bless the Lord</u>, <u>you His angels</u>, <u>Mighty in strength</u>, <u>who perform His word</u>, <u>Obeying the voice of His word</u>! ## **Declare!**

"The God I serve has <u>ABSOLUTE POWER</u> over the devil and all his demons!"
"I am <u>REDEEMED</u> by the <u>BLOOD OF THE LAMB</u>, out of the hand of the devil!"
"I declare that the <u>WIND</u> of the Holy Spirit will <u>OPEN THE PATH</u> to my future!"

- **Exodus 12** And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it. Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it. And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It is the Lord's Passover. Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. If 'So this day shall be to you a memorial; and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord throughout your generations. You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance.
- Psalm 105 <sup>37</sup> At last, God freed all the Hebrews from their slavery and sent them away laden with the silver and gold of Egypt. And not even one was feeble on their way out! <sup>38</sup> Egypt was relieved at their exodus, ready to see them go, for the terror of the Lord of the Hebrews had fallen upon them! TPT (...loaded with silver and gold...NLT)
- **Hebrews 8** <sup>6</sup> But now Jesus the Messiah has accepted a priestly ministry which far surpasses theirs, since he is the catalyst of <u>a better covenant which contains far more wonderful promises! TPT</u>
- **Proverbs 13** <sup>22</sup> A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, and <u>the wealth</u> <u>of the sinner is stored up for the righteous</u>. NASU
- **2 Corinthians 8** <sup>9</sup> For you have experienced the extravagant grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that <u>although he was infinitely rich</u>, <u>he impoverished himself for our sake</u>, <u>so that by his poverty</u>, <u>we could become rich beyond measure</u>. TPT
- **1 Corinthians 5** <sup>7</sup> Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. **For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed**. <sup>8</sup> **Therefore let us celebrate the feast**, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. NASU
- **1 Corinthians 10** <sup>16</sup> For when we pray for the blessing of the communion cup, isn't this our co-participation with the blood of Jesus? And the bread that we distribute, isn't this the bread of our co-participation with the body of Christ? <sup>17</sup> For although we're many, we become one loaf of bread and one body as we feast together on one loaf. TPT
- **1 Corinthians 11** <sup>23</sup> I have handed down to you what came to me by direct revelation from the Lord himself. The same night in which he was handed over, he took bread <sup>24</sup> and gave thanks. Then he distributed it to the disciples and said, "Take it and eat your fill. It is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me." <sup>25</sup> He did the same with the cup *of wine* after supper and said, "This cup seals the new covenant with my blood. Drink it—and whenever you drink this, do it to remember me." <sup>26</sup> Whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are retelling the story, proclaiming our Lord's death until he comes. TPT
