FORTY DAYS

Numbers 13 ¹ Then the Lord spoke to Moses saying, ² "Send out for yourself men so that they may spy out <u>the land of Canaan</u>, <u>which I am going to give to the sons of Israel</u>; you shall send a man from each of their fathers' tribes, every one a leader among them." ²⁵ When they returned from spying out the land, <u>at the end of forty days</u>, ²⁷ Thus they told him, and said, "We went in to the land where you sent us; and it certainly does flow with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. ²⁸ "Nevertheless, the people who live in the land are strong, and the cities are fortified and very large; and moreover, we saw the descendants of Anak there. ³⁰ Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses and said, "We should by all means go up and take possession of it, for we will surely overcome it." ³¹ But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are too strong for us." ³² So they gave out to the sons of Israel a bad report of the land which they had spied out, saying, "The land

through which we have gone, in spying it out, is a land that devours its inhabitants; and all the people whom we saw in it are men of great size. ³³ "There also we saw the Nephilim... and <u>we became like grasshoppers in our own sight</u>, and so we were in their sight." 14:6 Joshua and Caleb... ⁹ "<u>Only do not rebel against the Lord</u>; <u>and do not fear the people of the land</u>, for they will be our prey. Joshua 1 ¹ Now it came about after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' servant, saying, 2 "Moses My servant is dead; now therefore arise, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel. ³ "Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses. 5 "No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you. 6 "Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. 7 "Only be strong and very courageous; be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go. 8 "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success. 9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you **go.**" – NASU – 5:6 For the Israelites walked forty years in the wilderness…because they did not hearken to the voice of the Lord... 8 When they finished circumcising all the males of the nation, they remained in their places in the camp till they were healed. 9 And the Lord said to Joshua, This day have I rolled away the reproach (shame and disgrace) of Egypt from you. So the name of the place is called Gilgal [rolling] to this day. 10 And the Israelites encamped in Gilgal; and they kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at evening in the plains of Jericho. 11 And on that same day they ate the produce of the land: unleavened cakes and parched grain. 6:15 On the seventh day they rose early at daybreak and marched around the city as usual, only on that day they compassed the city seven times. ¹⁶ And the seventh time, when the priests had blown the trumpets, **Joshua said to the people**, Shout! For the Lord has given you the city. ²⁰ So the people shouted, and the trumpets were blown. When the people heard the sound of the trumpet, they raised a great shout, and [Jericho's] wall fell down in its place, so that the [Israelites] went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city. AMP

Hebrews 8 ⁶ But now Jesus the Messiah has accepted a priestly ministry which far surpasses theirs, since he is the catalyst of a better covenant which contains far more wonderful promises! TPT

Ephesians 1 ⁴ And he chose us to be his very own, joining us to himself even before he laid the foundation of the universe!
