### Excerpt from Chuck Pierce Email – March 11, 2020

During that Head of the Year 5780 gathering on September 26-29, 2019, I began to prophesy that the nations would come into turmoil until Passover. At Starting the Year Off Right 2020, God was saying that there would be a massive plague-like invasion that would test us through Passover. **“God has put a PAUSE until He sees who is willing to cross over with Him through His blood at Passover.”** This Passover will become a **dividing line** for our future!

I started prophesying last September that **this year would be a “True Passover.”** Even though we have celebrated many Passovers, the Spirit of God said this would be the year that **we would really have to understand Passover.** He said plague-like conditions would hit the earth, and February, March and April would be hellish. But **He was looking at nations to see which nations “PASSED OVER.”** I then began to see that **the real issue would be an economic rearrangement throughout the world.** I see that if we celebrate and honor His Blood, the death structure that is gripping these nations will shift at Passover. I see that death toll in the nations that celebrate and honor His Blood and acknowledge Him will start decreasing after Passover. But **remember, once the Israelites passed over they still had 40 days to press through into their promise.** They had great problems during that 40-day period, and **postponed their promise for 40 years. I decree that during this 40-day period there will be no postponement.** This is exactly what the Spirit of God said to me and what I have been saying since September. ## FORTY DAYS

Numbers 13<sup>1</sup> Then the Lord spoke to Moses saying, <sup>2</sup> "Send out for yourself men so that they may spy out **the land of Canaan, which I am going to give to the sons of Israel;** you shall send a man from each of their fathers' tribes, every one a leader among them." <sup>25</sup> When they returned from spying out the land, **at the end of forty days,** <sup>27</sup> Thus they told him, and said, "We went in to the land where you sent us; and it certainly does flow with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. <sup>28</sup> "Nevertheless, the people who live in the land are strong, and the cities are fortified and very large; and moreover, we saw the descendants of Anak there. <sup>30</sup> Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses and said, "We should by all means go up and take possession of it, for we will surely overcome it." <sup>31</sup> But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are too strong for us." <sup>32</sup> So they gave out to the sons of Israel a bad report of the land which they had spied out, saying, "The land

through which we have gone, in spying it out, is a land that devours its inhabitants; and all the people whom we saw in it are men of great size. <sup>33</sup> "There also we saw the Nephilim... and **we became like grasshoppers in our own sight**, and so we were in their sight." 14:6 Joshua and Caleb... <sup>9</sup> **"Only do not rebel against the Lord; and do not fear the people of the land**, for they will be our prey. Their protection has been removed from them, and the Lord is with us; do not fear them." <sup>11</sup> **The Lord said to Moses, "How long will this people spurn Me? And how long will they not believe in Me**, despite all the signs which I have performed in their midst? <sup>24</sup> "But My servant **Caleb, because he has had a different spirit and has followed Me fully, I will bring into the land** which he entered, **and his descendants shall take possession of it**. <sup>27</sup> "How long shall I bear with this evil congregation who are grumbling against Me? I have heard the complaints of the sons of Israel, which they are making against Me. <sup>28</sup> **"Say to them, 'As I live,' says the Lord, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will surely do to you;** NASU

## **FORTY YEARS**

Joshua 1 <sup>1</sup> Now it came about after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' servant, saying, <sup>2</sup> **"Moses My servant is dead; now therefore arise, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them**, to the sons of Israel. <sup>3</sup> "Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses. <sup>5</sup> "No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you. <sup>6</sup> **"Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them**. <sup>7</sup> **"Only be strong and very courageous**; be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, **so that you may have success wherever you go**. <sup>8</sup> "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but **you shall meditate on it day and night**, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for **then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success**. <sup>9</sup> "Have I not commanded you? **Be strong and courageous!** Do not tremble or be dismayed, **for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go**." – NASU – 5:6 For the Israelites walked forty years in the wilderness...because they did not hearken to the voice of the Lord... <sup>8</sup> When they finished circumcising all the males of the nation, they remained in their places in the camp till they were healed. <sup>9</sup> And the Lord said to Joshua, **This day have I rolled away the reproach (shame and disgrace) of Egypt from you**. So the name of the place is called Gilgal [rolling] to this day. <sup>10</sup> And the Israelites encamped in Gilgal; and **they kept the Passover** on the fourteenth day of the month at evening in the plains of Jericho. <sup>11</sup> And on that same day they ate the produce of the land: unleavened cakes and parched grain. 6:15 On the seventh day they rose early at daybreak and marched around the city as usual, only on that day they compassed the city seven times. <sup>16</sup> And the seventh time, when the priests had blown the trumpets, **Joshua said to the people, Shout! For the Lord has given you the city**. <sup>20</sup> So the people shouted, and the trumpets were blown. When the people heard the sound of the trumpet, **they raised a great shout, and [Jericho's] wall fell down in its place**, so that the [Israelites] went up into the city, every man straight before him, **and they took the city**. AMP

Hebrews 8 <sup>6</sup> **But now Jesus the Messiah has accepted a priestly ministry which far surpasses theirs, since he is the catalyst of a better covenant which contains far more wonderful promises!** TPT

Ephesians 1 <sup>4</sup> **And he chose us to be his very own**, joining us to himself even before he laid the foundation of the universe! **Because of his great love**, he ordained us, so that we would be seen as holy in his eyes with an unstained innocence. <sup>5-6</sup> For it was always in his perfect plan **to adopt us as his delightful children, through our union with Jesus**, the Anointed One, so that his tremendous love that cascades over us would glorify his grace — **for the same love he has for his Beloved One, Jesus, he has for us. And this unfolding plan brings him great pleasure!** <sup>7</sup> Since we are now joined to Christ, **we have been given the treasures of redemption by his blood** — the total cancellation of our sins—all because of the cascading riches of his grace.
