*During that Head of the Year 5780 gathering on September 26-29, 2019, I began to prophesy that the nations would come into turmoil until Passover. At Starting the Year Off Right 2020, God was saying that there would be a massive plague-like invasion that would test us through Passover. "God has put a PAUSE until He sees who is willing to cross over with Him through His blood at Passover." This Passover will become a **dividing line** for our future!*

Four Dividing Line Pauses and Passovers

Exodus 3 ² The angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush; and he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, yet the bush was not consumed. ³ So Moses said, **"I must turn aside now and see this marvelous sight,** why the bush is not burned up." ⁴ **When the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush** and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." ⁷ The Lord said, **"I have surely seen the affliction of My people** who are in Egypt, **and have given heed to their cry** because of their taskmasters, for **I am aware of their sufferings.** ⁸ **"So I have come down to deliver them from the power of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk and honey,** to the place of the Canaanite and the Hittite and the Amorite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite. 1. Exodus 12 ³ "Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, 'On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers' households, a lamb for each household. ⁷ 'Moreover, **they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.** ¹¹ 'Now you shall eat it in this manner: with your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste — **it is the Lord's Passover.** ¹³ **'The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you** when I

strike the land of Egypt. ¹⁴ 'Now this day will be a memorial to you, and **you shall celebrate it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.** ²¹ Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families, and **slay the Passover lamb.** ²² "You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and **apply some of the blood** that is in the basin **to the lintel and the two doorposts;** and **none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning.** ²³ "For the Lord will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and **when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to come in to your houses to smite you.** ²⁷ you shall say, 'It is a Passover sacrifice to the Lord who passed over the houses of the sons of Israel in Egypt when He smote the Egyptians, but spared our homes.'" And the people bowed low and worshiped. NASU

Psalm 105 ³⁷ **At last, God freed all the Hebrews from their slavery and sent them away laden with the silver and gold of Egypt. And not even one was feeble on their way out!** TPT

2. Joshua 5 ¹ Now it came about when all the kings of the Amorites who were beyond the Jordan to the west, and all the kings of the Canaanites who were by the sea, heard how the Lord had dried up the waters of the Jordan before the sons of Israel until they had crossed, that their hearts melted, and there was no spirit in them any longer because of the sons of Israel. ² At that time the Lord said to Joshua, "Make for yourself flint knives and **circumcise again** the sons of Israel the second time." ⁸ **Now when they had finished circumcising all the nation, they remained in their places in the camp until they were healed.** ⁹ Then the Lord said to Joshua, "**Today I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you.**" So the name of that place is called Gilgal to this day. ¹⁰ While the sons of Israel camped at Gilgal **they observed the Passover on the evening of the fourteenth day of the month on the desert plains of Jericho.** ¹¹ **On the day after the Passover, on that very day, they ate some of the produce of the land,** unleavened cakes and parched grain. ¹² **The manna ceased on the day after they had eaten some of the produce of the land,** so that the sons of Israel no longer had manna, but they ate some of the yield of the land of Canaan during that year. ¹³ Now it came about when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, a man was standing opposite him with his sword drawn in his hand, and Joshua went to him and said to him, "Are you for us or for our adversaries?" ¹⁴ He said, "**No; rather I indeed come now as captain of the host of the Lord.**" And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and bowed down, and said to him, "What has my lord to say to his servant?" ¹⁵ The captain of the Lord's host said to Joshua, "Remove your sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy." And Joshua did so. NASU

Joshua 6 ¹⁵ Then on the seventh day they rose early at the dawning of the day and marched around the city in the same manner seven times; only on that day they marched around the city seven times. ¹⁶ At the seventh time, when the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "**Shout! For the Lord has given you the city.** ¹⁸ "But as for you, only keep yourselves from the things under the ban, so that you do not covet them and take some of the things under the ban, and make the camp of Israel accursed and bring trouble on it. ¹⁹ **But all the silver and gold and articles of bronze and iron are holy to the Lord; they shall go into the treasury of the Lord.**" NASU
