Matthew 13 ⁵⁸ And their great unbelief kept him from doing any mighty miracles *in Nazareth*. TPT **Mark 6** ⁵ <u>He was unable to do any great miracle in Nazareth</u>, except to heal a few sick people by laying his hands upon them. ⁶ <u>He was amazed at the depth of their unbelief</u>! Then Jesus went out into the different villages and taught the people. - TPT - ^{5a} And He was not able to do even one work of power there... ^{6a} And He marveled because of their unbelief (their lack of faith in Him). AMP

Psalm 78 ⁴¹ <u>Again and again they limited God</u>, <u>preventing him from blessing them</u>... ⁴² <u>They</u> <u>forgot his great love</u>, how he took them by his hand, and with redemption's kiss he delivered them from their enemies. TPT

HOW DO YOU SEE YOURSELF? WHAT DO YOU BELIEVE ABOUT YOURSELF AND GOD?

Romans 8 ¹⁷ <u>And since we are his true children</u>, <u>we qualify to share all his treasures</u>, for indeed, <u>we are heirs of God himself</u>. And since we are joined to Christ, <u>we also inherit all that he is and all that he has</u>. We will experience being co-glorified with him provided that we accept his sufferings as our own. TPT

IF IT HAPPENED TO JESUS IT HAPPENED TO ME!

1 John 4 ^{17b}...because all that Jesus now is, so are we in this world. TPT

James 1 ²² Don't just listen to the Word of Truth and not respond to it, for that is the essence of self-deception. ²⁴ <u>You perceive how God sees you in the mirror of the Word</u>, <u>but then you go out</u> <u>and forget your DIVINE ORIGIN</u>. ²⁵ But those who set their gaze deeply into the perfecting law of liberty are fascinated by and respond to the truth they hear and are strengthened by it—they experience God's blessing in all that they do! TPT

Numbers 13 ^{33b} ...<u>and we became like grasshoppers in our own sight</u>, and so we were in their sight." NASU

Numbers 14 ¹¹ And the Lord said to Moses, How long will this people provoke (spurn, despise) Me? And how long will it be before they believe Me [trusting in, relying on, clinging to Me], for all the signs which I have performed among them? AMP

Joshua 5 ⁸ Now when they had finished circumcising all the nation, they remained in their places in the camp until they were healed. ⁹ Then the Lord said to Joshua, "<u>Today I have rolled away the reproach (shame and disgrace) of Egypt from you</u>." So the name of that place is called Gilgal to this day. ¹⁰ While the sons of Israel camped at Gilgal <u>they observed the Passover</u> on the evening of the fourteenth day of the month on the desert plains of Jericho. ^{11a} On the day after the Passover, on that very day, they ate some of the produce of the land... ¹² ...but they ate some of the yield of the land of Canaan during that year. NASU

Joshua 6 ¹⁶ At the seventh time, when the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "<u>Shout</u>! <u>For the Lord has given you the city</u>.²⁰ So the people shouted, and priests blew the

trumpets; and when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, the people shouted with a great shout and **the wall fell down flat**, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight ahead, and **they took the city**. NASU

Isaiah 1¹⁹ "If you consent and obey, <u>You will eat the best of the land;</u> NASU

DO YOU SEE YOURSELF WITH THE BEST?

1 Peter 2 ²⁴ and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for <u>by His wounds you were healed</u>. NASU

DO YOU SEE YOURSELF AS THE HEALED?

2 Corinthians 8 ⁹ For you have experienced the extravagant grace of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, that <u>although he was infinitely rich</u>, he impoverished himself for our sake, <u>so that by his poverty</u>, <u>we</u> <u>could become rich beyond measure</u>. TPT

DO YOU SEE YOURSELF AS RICH BEYOND MEASURE?

Deuteronomy 8 ¹⁸ "But you shall remember the Lord your God, for <u>it is He who is giving you</u> <u>power to make wealth</u>, that He may confirm His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. NASU

DO YOU SEE YOURSELF AS HAVING POWER TO MAKE WEALTH?

Deuteronomy 15⁴ "However, there will be no poor among you, since the Lord will surely bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance to possess NASU

Proverbs 10²² It is the blessing of the Lord that makes rich, And He adds no sorrow to it. NASU

DO YOU SEE YOURSELF AS BLESSED AND RICH?

Proverbs 13 ²² A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, And <u>the wealth of the</u> <u>sinner is stored up for</u> [the hands of] <u>the righteous</u>. AMP

DO YOU SEE THE WEALTH OF THE SINNER TRANSFERRING TO YOU (THE RIGHTEOUS)?

Ecclesiastes 2 ²⁶ For to the person who pleases Him God gives wisdom and knowledge and joy; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and heaping up, that he may give to one who pleases God. AMP

DO YOU SEE THE SINNER GATHERING FOR YOU?

1 Corinthians 1 ³⁰ But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us <u>wisdom</u> from God, and <u>righteousness</u> and <u>sanctification</u>, and <u>redemption</u>, NASU

DO YOU SEE YOURSELF WISE, RIGHTEOUS, SANCTIFIED AND REDEEMED?

Galatians 3 ⁶ Thus Abraham believed in and adhered to and trusted in and relied on God, and it was reckoned and placed to his account and credited as righteousness (as conformity to the divine will in purpose, thought, and action). [Gen 15:6.] ⁷ Know and understand that it is [really] the people [who live] by faith who are [the true] sons of Abraham. ⁹ So then, those who are people of faith are blessed and made happy and favored by God [as partners in fellowship] with the believing and trusting Abraham.

¹³ <u>Christ purchased our freedom</u> [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] <u>by [Himself] becoming a curse for us</u>, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); [Deut 21:23.] ¹⁴ <u>To the end that</u> through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, <u>the blessing [promised]</u> to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles, <u>so that we through faith might [all] receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit</u>. AMP
