Galatians 3 <sup>13</sup> <u>Christ purchased our freedom</u> [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] <u>by</u> [<u>Himself</u>] <u>becoming a curse for us</u>, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); [Deut 21:23.] <sup>14</sup> <u>To the end that</u> through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, <u>the blessing</u> [<u>promised</u>] <u>to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles</u>, <u>so that we through faith might</u> [<u>all</u>] <u>receive</u> [<u>the realization of</u>] <u>the promise of the [Holy</u>] <u>Spirit</u>.

**John 16** <sup>7</sup> "But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, **the Helper** will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. <sup>8</sup> "And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; <sup>9</sup> concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; <sup>10</sup> and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; <sup>11</sup> and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged. <sup>13</sup> "But when He, **the Spirit of truth**, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and **He will disclose to you what is to come**. <sup>14</sup> "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you. NASU

John 20 <sup>21</sup> So Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you." <sup>22</sup> And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the

<u>Holy Spirit</u>. <sup>23</sup> "If you forgive the sins of any, their sins have been forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they have been retained." NASU

**Luke 24** <sup>49</sup> "And behold, I am sending forth <u>the promise</u> of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are <u>clothed with power from on high</u>." NASU

Acts 1 <sup>1</sup> The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach, <sup>2</sup> until the day when He was taken up to heaven, after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen. <sup>3</sup> To these He also presented Himself alive after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over a period of <u>forty days</u> and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. <sup>4</sup> Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me; <sup>5</sup> for John baptized with water, but <u>you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now</u>." <sup>8</sup> but <u>you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you</u>; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth." NASU

Acts 2 1 When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance. 5 Now there were Jews living in Jerusalem, devout men from every nation under heaven. <sup>6</sup> And when this sound occurred, the crowd came together, and were bewildered because each one of them was hearing them speak in his own language. <sup>7</sup> They were amazed and astonished, saying, "Why, are not all these who are speaking Galileans? 8 "And how is it that we each hear them in our own language to which we were born? 11 ... we hear them in our own tongues speaking of the mighty deeds of God." 12 And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" 13 But others were mocking and saying, "They are full of sweet wine." <sup>14</sup> But Peter, taking his stand with the eleven, raised his voice and declared to them: "Men of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you and give heed to my words. <sup>15</sup> "For these men are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only the third hour of the day: 16 but this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel: 17 'AND IT SHALL BE IN THE LAST DAYS,' God says, 'THAT I WILL POUR FORTH OF MY SPIRIT ON ALL MANKIND: AND YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS SHALL PROPHESY. AND YOUR YOUNG MEN SHALL SEE VISIONS, AND YOUR OLD MEN SHALL DREAM DREAMS: 18 EVEN ON MY BONDSLAVES. BOTH MEN AND WOMEN. I WILL IN THOSE DAYS POUR FORTH OF MY SPIRIT And they shall prophesy. <sup>21</sup> 'AND IT SHALL BE THAT EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.' 36 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ — this Jesus whom you crucified." 37 Now when they heard this, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?" 38 Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

39 "For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself." 40 And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!" 41 So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls. 42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 46 Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved. NASU

**Luke 11** <sup>13</sup> "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, <u>how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him</u>?" NASU
