"God has put a PAUSE until He sees who is willing to cross over with Him through His blood at Passover." This Passover will become a <u>dividing line</u> for our future!

I started prophesying last September that <u>this year would be a</u> "<u>True Passover</u>." Even though we have celebrated many Passovers, the Spirit of God said this would be the year that <u>we would really have to understand Passover</u>. <u>He was looking at nations to see which nations</u> "<u>PASSED</u> <u>OVER</u>." I then began to see that <u>the real issue would be an economic rearrangement throughout the world</u>. But <u>remember</u>, <u>once the Israelites passed over they still had 40 days to press</u> <u>through into their promise</u>. They had great problems during that 40-day period, and <u>postponed</u> <u>their promise for 40 years</u>. <u>I decree that during this 40-day period there will be no postponement</u>.

GOD BROUGHT THEM <u>OUT</u> OF THE CURSE TO BRING THEM <u>INTO</u> THE BLESSING!

Psalm 78 ⁴¹ <u>Again and again they limited God</u>, <u>preventing him from blessing them</u>... ⁴² <u>They</u> <u>forgot his great love</u>, how he took them by his hand, and with redemption's kiss he delivered them from their enemies. TPT

Psalm 8 ³ When I view and consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained and established, ⁴ What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of [earthborn] man that You care for him? ⁵ <u>Yet You have made him but a little lower than</u> <u>God</u>, and You have crowned him with glory and honor. ⁶ You made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet: [1 Cor 15:27; Eph 1:22,23; Heb 2:6-8.] AMP

Genesis 1 ²⁶ <u>God said</u>, <u>Let Us</u> [Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] <u>make mankind in Our image</u>, <u>after</u> <u>Our likeness</u>, <u>and let them have complete authority</u> over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the [tame] beasts, and <u>over all of the earth</u>, and over everything that creeps upon the earth. ²⁷ So God created man in His own image, in the image *and* likeness of God He created him; <u>male and</u> <u>female He created them</u>. ²⁸ <u>And God blessed them</u> and said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [using all its vast resources in the service of God and man]; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and over every living creature that moves upon the earth. 2 Peter 1 ⁴As a result of this, he has given you magnificent promises that are beyond all price, <u>so</u> that through the power of these tremendous promises you can experience partnership with the divine nature, by which you have escaped the corrupt desires that are of the world. TPT

Romans 8 ¹⁷ And since we are his true children, we qualify to share all his treasures, for indeed, <u>we are heirs of God himself</u>. And since we are joined to Christ, <u>we also inherit all that he is and all that he has</u>. We will experience being co-glorified with him provided that we accept his sufferings as our own. TPT

Deuteronomy 30 ¹⁹ I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you today, that <u>I have set before</u> you life and death, the blessing and the curse; therefore, you shall choose life in order that

James 1²² Don't just listen to the Word of Truth and not respond to it, for that is the essence of self-deception. So always let his Word become like poetry written and fulfilled by your life!²³ If you listen to the Word and don't live out the message you hear, you become like the person who looks in the mirror of the Word to discover the reflection of his face in the beginning.²⁴ <u>You perceive how</u> <u>God sees you in the mirror of the Word</u>, but then you go out and forget your divine origin.²⁵ But those who set their gaze deeply into the perfecting law of liberty are fascinated by and respond to the truth they hear and are strengthened by it—they experience God's blessing in all that they do!²⁶ If someone believes they have a relationship with God but fails to guard his words then his heart is drifting away and his religion is shallow and empty. TPT

Numbers 13 ³⁰ Then <u>Caleb</u> quieted the people before Moses and said, "<u>We should by all means</u> <u>go up and take possession of it</u>, <u>for we will surely overcome it</u>." ³¹ But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are too strong for us." ^{33b} ...<u>and</u> <u>we became like grasshoppers in our own sight</u>, and so we were in their sight." 14:1 Then all the congregation lifted up their voices and cried, and the people wept that night. ² All the sons of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron; and the whole congregation said to them, "Would that we had died in the land of Egypt! Or would that we had died in this wilderness! NASU

Joshua 5 ⁶ **For the sons of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness**, until all the nation, that is, the men of war who came out of Egypt, perished <u>because they did not listen to the voice of the</u> **Lord**, to whom the Lord had sworn that He would not let them see the land which the Lord had sworn to their fathers to give us, a land flowing with milk and honey. ⁷ Their children whom He raised up in their place, Joshua circumcised; for they were uncircumcised, because they had not circumcised them along the way. ⁸ Now when they had finished circumcising all the nation, they remained in their places in the camp until they were healed. ⁹ Then the Lord said to Joshua, "**Today I have rolled away the reproach (shame and disgrace) of Egypt from you**." So the name of that place is called Gilgal to this day. ¹⁰ While the sons of Israel camped at Gilgal **they observed the Passover** on the evening of the fourteenth day of the month on the desert plains of Jericho. ¹¹ On the day after the Passover, on that very day, they ate some of the produce of the land, unleavened cakes and parched grain. ¹² The manna ceased on the day after they had eaten some of the produce of the land, so that the sons of Israel no longer had manna, but they ate some of the yield of the land of Canaan during that year. NASU

Joshua 6 ¹⁵ Then on the seventh day they rose early at the dawning of the day and marched around the city in the same manner seven times; only on that day they marched around the city seven times. ¹⁶ At the seventh time, when the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "<u>Shout</u>! <u>For</u> <u>the Lord has given you the city</u>. ²⁰ So the people shouted, and priests blew the trumpets; and when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, the people shouted with a great shout and <u>the wall fell</u> <u>down flat</u>, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight ahead, and <u>they took the city</u>. NASU

Isaiah 1¹⁹ "If you consent and obey, <u>You will eat the best of the land;</u> NASU ¹⁹ If you are willing and obedient... AMP

1 Peter 2 ²⁴ and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for <u>by His wounds you were healed</u>. NASU

2 Corinthians 8 ⁹ For you have experienced the extravagant grace of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, that <u>although he was infinitely rich</u>, he impoverished himself for our sake, <u>so that by his poverty</u>, <u>we</u> <u>could become rich beyond measure</u>. TPT

Deuteronomy 8 ¹⁸ "But you shall remember the Lord your God, for <u>it is He who is giving you</u> <u>power to make wealth</u>, that He may confirm His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. NASU

Proverbs 10²² It is the blessing of the Lord that makes rich, And He adds no sorrow to it. NASU

Proverbs 13 ²² A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, And <u>the wealth of the</u> <u>sinner is stored up for</u> [the hands of] <u>the righteous</u>. AMP

Ecclesiastes 2 ²⁶ For to the person who pleases Him God gives wisdom and knowledge and joy; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and heaping up, that he may give to one who pleases God. AMP

1 Corinthians 1 ³⁰ But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption, NASU

Galatians 3 ⁶ Thus Abraham believed in and adhered to and trusted in and relied on God, and it was reckoned and placed to his account and credited as righteousness (as conformity to the divine will in purpose, thought, and action). [Gen 15:6.] ⁷ Know and understand that it is [really] the people [who live] by faith who are [the true] sons of Abraham. ⁹ So then, those who are people of faith are blessed and made happy and favored by God [as partners in fellowship] with the believing and trusting Abraham. ¹³ <u>Christ purchased our freedom</u> [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] <u>by [Himself] becoming a curse for us</u>, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); [Deut 21:23.] ¹⁴ <u>To the end that</u> through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, <u>the blessing [promised] to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles</u>, <u>so that we through faith might [all] receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit</u>.
