Genesis 15 ¹³ God said to Abram "Your descendants will be slaves in a foreign land and will be oppressed for 400 years. ¹⁴ But then I will judge the nation that enslaves them. When that time comes, your descendants will emerge with great wealth! "judge" Strong's: diyn (deen): ACT AS JUDGE, GOVERN, MINISTER JUDGMENT, PLEAD A CAUSE (ADVOCATE), VINDICATE, EXECUTE JUDGMENT.

Genesis 22 ¹ Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." ² Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you." ³ So Abraham got up early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him and his son Isaac; and he split wood for the burnt offering, and set out and went to the place of which God had told him. ⁴ On the third day Abraham raised his eyes and saw the place from a distance. ⁵ Then Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey, and I and the boy will go over there; and we will worship and return to you." ⁹ Then they came to the place of which God had told him; and Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood, and bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. ¹⁰ And Abraham reached out with his hand and took the knife to slaughter his son. ¹¹ But the angel of the Lord called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." ¹² He said, "Do not reach out your hand against the boy, and do not do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me." ¹³ Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind *him* was a ram caught in the thicket by its horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering in the place of his son. ¹⁴ And Abraham named that place The Lord Will Provide, as it is said to this day, "On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided."

Job 13 ¹⁵ "Even though He kills me; I will hope in Him. Nevertheless, I will argue my ways to His face. AMP

(Isaiah 45 & 30 are the first 2 prophecies I received – given by Dick Mills)

Isaiah 45 ² I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron: ³ And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the Lord, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel. ⁴ For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known me. KJV

Isaiah 30 ¹⁸ Therefore **the Lord waits [expectantly] and longs to be gracious to you**, And therefore He waits on high to have compassion on you. For **the Lord is a God of justice; Blessed** (happy, fortunate) are all those who long for Him [since He will never fail them]. ²⁰ **Though the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of oppression**, yet your Teacher will no longer hide Himself, but your eyes will [constantly] see your Teacher. ²¹ **Your ears will hear a word behind you, "This is the way, walk in it,"** whenever you turn to the right or to the left. AMP

Genesis 37 ² ...**Joseph**, when he **was seventeen years of age**, was pasturing the flock with his brothers, while he was still a youth... ⁴ And his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers... ⁵ Then **Joseph had a dream**, and when he told it to his brothers, they hated him even more. ⁶ He said to them... ⁷ for behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and behold, my sheaf stood up and also remained standing; and behold, your sheaves gathered around and bowed down to my sheaf ⁹ Then **he had yet another dream**, and informed his brothers of it, and said... "and behold, the sun and the moon, and eleven stars were bowing down to me." ¹⁰ He also told *it* to his father as well as to his brothers; and his father rebuked him... ¹⁴ Then he said to him, "Go now and see about the welfare of your brothers and the welfare of the flock, and bring word back to me." ¹⁸ When they saw him from a distance...they plotted against him to put him to death. ²⁶ And Judah said to his brothers, "What profit is it for us to kill our brother and cover up his blood? ²⁷ ..**let's sell him to the Ishmaelite...**" ²⁸ Then some Midianite traders passed by...and sold him... ³⁶ Meanwhile, **the Midianites sold him in Egypt to Potiphar...** ^{39:1} ...Potiphar, an Egyptian officer of Pharaoh...bought him from the Ishmaelites... ² And the **Lord was with Joseph, so he became a successful man...** ³ Now his master saw that the Lord was with him and *that* **the Lord made all that he did prosper in his hand.** ⁴ So Joseph found favor in his sight and became...in charge of all that he owned. ⁷ And it came about after these events that his master's wife had her eyes on Joseph, and she said, "Sleep with me." ⁸ But he refused... "Look, with me *here*, my master...has put me in charge of all that he owns. ⁹ There is no one greater in this house than I... How then could I do this great evil, and sin against God?" ¹² So she grabbed him by his garment, saying, "Sleep with me!" But he left his garment in her hand and fled... ¹⁹ Now when his master heard the words of his wife which she spoke to him...his anger burned. ²⁰ So Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison... ²¹ **But the Lord was with Joseph and extended kindness to him...** ²³ The warden of the prison did not supervise anything under Joseph's authority...the Lord made whatever he did prosper. ^{40:20} So it came about on the third day, *which was Pharaoh's birthday*, that he held a feast for all his servants... ²³ **Yet the chief cupbearer did not remember Joseph, but forgot him.** ^{41:1} Now it happened **at the end of two full years that Pharaoh had a dream...** ¹⁴ Then Pharaoh sent *word* and called for Joseph, and they hurriedly brought him out of the dungeon...he came to Pharaoh. ¹⁵ Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I have had a dream, but no one can interpret it; and I have heard it said about you, that when you hear a dream you can interpret it." ³⁸ Then Pharaoh said to his servants, "Can we find a man like this, in whom there is a divine spirit?" ³⁹ So Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Since God has informed you of all this... ⁴⁰ You shall be in charge of my house, and all my people shall be obedient to you..." ⁴¹ Pharaoh also said to Joseph, "See, I have placed you over all the land of Egypt." ⁴² **Then Pharaoh took off his signet ring...and put it on Joseph's hand...** ⁴³ And he had him ride in his second chariot...!" And he placed him over all the land of Egypt. ⁴⁴ Moreover, Pharaoh said to Joseph, "*Though* I am Pharaoh, yet without your permission no one shall raise his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt." ⁴⁵ Then Pharaoh named Joseph Zaphenath-paneah; and he gave him Asenath, the daughter of Potiphara...to be *his* wife... ⁴⁶ **Now Joseph was thirty years old when he stood in the presence of Pharaoh, king of Egypt...** NASU
