



Promises, Promises! Salvation & Healing

July 25, 2021 – Part 5

Acts 4 ¹¹ This Jesus is the STONE WHICH WAS DESPISED *and* REJECTED by you, THE BUILDERS, *but* WHICH BECAME THE CHIEF CORNERSTONE. ¹² **And there is *salvation* in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among people by which we must be saved [for God has provided the world no alternative for *salvation*].** AMP

¹² There is no one else who has the power to **save** us, for there is only one name to whom God has given authority by which we must experience **salvation: *the name of Jesus***.” TPT

Save, *yasha'* (yah-shah); (Hebrew) Strong's #3467: To rescue, save, defend: to free, preserve, avenge, deliver, help. The verb, found more than 200 times throughout the OT, is a one-word description of God's response to the needs of humanity. God chose a form of this verb to be His Son's name: **Yeshua**, meaning **He Shall Save**.” The original thought of *yasha'* was “to release,” “to open wide.” Our Deliverer is the One who opened wide the gates of captivity, released and rescued us, and continually defends and preserves us.

1 Timothy 2 ¹ I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. ² Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. ³ **This is good and pleases God our Savior**, ⁴ **who wants everyone to be saved** and to understand the truth. ⁵ For, There is one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus. ⁶ He gave his life to purchase freedom for everyone. This is the message God gave to the world at just the right time. NLT

Saved, *sozo* (sode-zoe); (Greek) Strong's #4982: To **save, heal, cure, preserve**, keep safe and sound, rescue from danger or destruction, deliver. *Sozo* saves from physical death by healing, and from spiritual death by forgiving sin and its effects. *Sozo* in primitive cultures is translated simply, “to give new life” and “to cause to have a new heart.”

God wants **everyone** saved! To **save also means healed**, therefore, **it is God's will for you to be healed!**

1 John 5 ¹⁴ Since we have this confidence, we can also have **great boldness** before him, for if we ask anything agreeable to his will, he will hear us. ¹⁵ **And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we also know that we have obtained the requests we ask of him.** TPT

Luke 18 ³⁵ As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind beggar was sitting beside the road. ³⁶ When he heard the noise of a crowd going past, he asked what was happening. ³⁷ They told him that Jesus the Nazarene was going by. ³⁸ **So he began shouting, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!”** ³⁹ “Be quiet!” the people in front yelled at him. **But he only shouted louder, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”** ⁴⁰ When Jesus heard him, he stopped and ordered that the man be brought to him. As the man came near, Jesus asked him, ⁴¹ **“What do you want me to do for you?” “Lord,” he said, “I want to see!”** ⁴² **And Jesus said, “All right, receive your sight! Your faith has healed you.”** ⁴³ Instantly the man could see, and he followed Jesus, praising God. And all who saw it praised God, too. TPT

Romans 10 ⁵ For Moses writes that the law's way of making a person right with God requires obedience to all of its commands. ⁶ But faith's way of getting right with God says, “Don't say in your heart, ‘Who will go up to heaven?’ (to bring Christ down to earth). ⁷ And don't say, ‘Who will go down to the place of the dead?’ (to bring Christ back to life again).” ⁸ In fact, it says, “The message is very close at hand; it is on your lips and in your heart.” And that message is the very message about faith that we preach: ⁹ **If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.** ¹⁰ **For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right**

with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved. NLT - ⁹ And what is God's "living message"? It is the revelation of faith for salvation, which is the message that we preach. For if you publicly declare with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will experience salvation. ¹⁰ **The heart that believes in him receives the gift of the righteousness of God—and then the mouth confesses, resulting in salvation [healing].** TPT

Exodus 15 ^{26b} **I, the LORD, am your healer.** NASB

Hebrews 8 ⁶ But now Jesus the Messiah has accepted a priestly ministry which far surpasses theirs, since he is the catalyst of a **better covenant which contains far more wonderful promises!** TPT

Isaiah 53 ⁴ However, *it was* our sicknesses *that* He Himself bore, and our pains *that* He carried; Yet we ourselves assumed that He had been afflicted, Struck down by God, and humiliated. ⁵ But He was pierced for our offenses, He was crushed for our wrongdoings; The punishment for our well-being *was laid* upon Him, and **by His wounds we are healed.** NASB - **1 Peter 2** ²⁴ He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree [as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. **By His wounds you have been healed.** AMPC

Psalms 118 ¹⁷ **I will not die, but live,** and tell of the works of the LORD. NASB

Jeremiah 30 ^{17a} **'For I will restore health to you and I will heal your wounds,'** says the LORD AMP

Psalms 103 ² Yahweh, you are my soul's celebration. How could I ever forget the miracles of kindness you've done for me? ³ You kissed my heart with forgiveness, in spite of all I've done. **You've healed me inside and out from every disease.** ⁴ You've rescued me from hell and saved my life. You've crowned me with love and mercy. ⁵ You satisfy my every desire with good things. You've supercharged my life so that I soar again like a flying eagle in the sky! ⁶ You're a God who makes things right, giving justice to the defenseless. TPT

Matthew 8 ¹ After he came down from teaching on the hillside, massive crowds began following him. ² Suddenly, a leper walked up to Jesus and threw himself down before him in worship and said, "Lord, you have the power to heal me . . . if you really want to." ³ Jesus reached out his hand and touched the leper and said, **Of course I want to heal you—be healed!** And instantly, all signs of leprosy disappeared! TPT

Matthew 8 ¹⁶ That evening the people brought to him many who were demonized. And by Jesus only speaking a word of healing over them, they were totally set free from their torment, and **everyone who was sick received their healing!** ¹⁷ In doing this, Jesus fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: **He put upon himself our weaknesses, and he carried away our diseases and made us well.** TPT

John 14 ¹² "I tell you this timeless truth: The person who follows me in faith, believing in me, will do the same mighty miracles that I do—even greater miracles than these because I go to be with my Father! ¹³ **For I will do whatever you ask me to do when you ask me in my name.** . . . TPT

Acts 10 ³⁸ "Jesus of Nazareth was anointed by God with the Holy Spirit and with great power. He did wonderful things for others and **divinely healed all who were under the tyranny of the devil** [slanderer-liar], **for God had anointed him.** TPT

Mark 16 ¹⁵ And he said to them, "As you go into all the world, preach openly the wonderful news of the gospel to the entire human race! ¹⁶ **Whoever believes the good news and is baptized will be saved,** and whoever does not believe the good news will be condemned. ¹⁷ And these miracle signs will accompany those who believe: They will drive out demons in the power of my name. They will speak in tongues. ¹⁸ They will be supernaturally protected from snakes and from drinking anything poisonous. **And they will lay hands on the sick and heal them.**" TPT

3 John 2 **Beloved friend, I pray that you are prospering in every way and that you continually enjoy good health, just as your soul is prospering.** TPT
