Daniel 2 ³⁴ "You continued looking until a stone was cut out without hands, and it struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them. ³⁵ "Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were crushed all at the same time and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away so that not a trace of them was found. But the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and filled the whole earth. ⁴⁴ "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever. NASU

Luke 22 ²⁰ And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood." NASU

Hebrews 8 ¹³ When He said, "A new covenant," He has made the first obsolete. But whatever is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to disappear. NASU

The disciples believed that they were living in the end times. Were they right?

1 Peter 1 ¹⁹ but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ. ²⁰ For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you NASU (Also see Acts 2:16-17, 1 Corinthians 10:11, Hebrews 1:1-2, James 5:3)

1 John 2 ¹⁸ Boys (lads), it is the last time (hour, the end of this age). And as you have heard that the antichrist [he who will oppose Christ in the guise of Christ] is coming, even now many antichrists have arisen, which confirms our belief that it is the final (the end) time. AMP

Revelation 1 ¹ [THIS IS] the revelation of Jesus Christ [His unveiling of the divine mysteries]. God gave it to Him to disclose and make known to His bond servants certain things which must shortly and speedily come to pass in their entirety... ³ Blessed (happy, to be envied) is the man who reads aloud [in the assemblies] the word of this prophecy; and blessed (happy, to be envied) are those who hear [it read] and who keep themselves true to the things which are written in it [heeding them and laying them to heart], for the time [for them to be fulfilled] is near. AMP

Matthew 16 ²⁸ "Truly I say to you, there are some of those who are standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom." NASU

Matthew 23 ³⁶ "Truly I say to you, all these things will come upon this generation."
³⁸ "Behold, your house is being left to you desolate!" ³⁹ "For I say to you, from now on you will not see Me until you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!'" NASU

Matthew 24 ³⁴ "Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place." NASU

The end-times was the period in which God abolished the old by establishing the new. It went from the day Jesus revealed Himself as Messiah to the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem in A.D. 70. The end-times took place during the first century. We do not live in the end-times. We live in new times! In a new kingdom and a new covenant!

There is a rapture ahead of us and the second coming of Jesus to the earth and the day of the Lord (or judgment day). There is no Great Tribulation, Antichrist, Mark of the Beast, or one world government ahead of us; those things have already taken place. The Kingdom of God will advance and increase in the earth until Jesus comes back!

Acts 3 ¹⁹ So repent (change your mind and purpose); turn around and return [to God], that your sins may be erased (blotted out, wiped clean), that times of refreshing (of recovering from the effects of heat, of reviving with fresh air) may come from the presence of the Lord; ²⁰ And that He may send [to you] the Christ (the Messiah), Who before was designated and appointed for you--even Jesus, ²¹ Whom heaven must receive [and retain] until the time for the complete restoration of all that God spoke by the mouth of all His holy prophets for ages past [from the most ancient time in the memory of man]. AMP
