Daniel 2 ³⁴ "You continued looking until <u>a stone was cut out without hands</u>, <u>and it struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them</u>. ³⁵ "Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were <u>crushed all at the same time</u> and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away so that <u>not a trace of them was found</u>. <u>But the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and *filled the whole earth*. ⁴⁴ "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a <u>kingdom which will never be destroyed</u>, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; <u>it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms</u>, <u>but it will itself endure forever</u>. NASU (Pages 102 & 103)</u>

The Mustard Seed - Matthew 13 ³¹ He presented another parable to them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and sowed in his field; ³² and this is smaller than all other seeds, but when it is full grown, it is larger than the garden plants and becomes a tree, so that THE BIRDS OF THE AIR come and NEST IN ITS BRANCHES." NASU

The Leaven – Matthew 13 ³³ He spoke another parable to them, "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three pecks of flour until it was all leavened." NASU

Tares Among Wheat - Matthew 13 ²⁴ Jesus presented another parable to them, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field. ²⁵ "But while his men were sleeping, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went away. ²⁶ "But when the wheat sprouted and bore grain, then the tares became evident also. ²⁷ "The slaves of the landowner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares?' ²⁸ "And he said to them, 'An enemy has done this!' The slaves said to him, 'Do you want us, then, to go and gather them up?' ²⁹ "But he said, 'No; for while you are gathering up the tares, you may uproot the wheat with them. ³⁰ 'Allow both to grow together until the harvest; and in the time of the harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather up the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them up; but gather the wheat into my barn."" NASU

The Tares Explained - Matthew 13 ³⁶ Then He left the crowds and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the tares of the field." ³⁷ And He said, "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man, ³⁸ and the field is the world; and as for the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom; and the tares are the sons of the evil one; ³⁹ and the enemy who sowed them is the devil, and the harvest is the end of the age; and the reapers are angels. ⁴⁰ "So just as the tares are gathered up and burned with fire, so shall it be at the end of the age. ⁴¹ "The Son of Man will send forth His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who commit lawlessness, ⁴² and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. ⁴³ "Then THE RIGHTEOUS WILL SHINE FORTH AS THE SUN in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear. NASU

- Isaiah 60 ¹ "Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you. ² "For behold, darkness will cover the earth and deep darkness the peoples; but the LORD will rise upon you and His glory will appear upon you. ³ "Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising. - **1 John 2** ¹⁸ Boys (lads), <u>it is the last time</u> (<u>hour</u>, <u>the end of this age</u>). And as you have heard that the antichrist [he who will oppose Christ in the guise of Christ] is coming, <u>even now many antichrists have arisen</u>, <u>which confirms our belief that it is the final (the end) time</u>. AMP

Matthew 16 ²⁸ "Truly I say to you, there are some of those who are standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom." NASU

Matthew 23 ³⁶ "Truly I say to you, all these things will come upon this generation."

38 "Behold, your house is being left to you desolate! 39 "For I say to you, from now on you will not see Me until you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!" NASU

1 Thessalonians 4 Now also we would not have you ignorant, brethren, about those who fall asleep [in death], that you may not grieve [for them] as the rest do who have no hope [beyond the grave]. 14 For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will also bring with Him through Jesus those who have fallen asleep [in death]. For this we declare to you by the Lord's [own] word, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord shall in no way precede [into His presence] or have any advantage at all over those who have previously fallen asleep [in Him in death]. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a loud cry of summons, with the shout of an archangel, and with the blast of the trumpet of God. And those who have departed this life in Christ will rise first. Then we, the living ones who remain [on the earth], shall simultaneously be caught up along with [the resurrected dead] in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; and so always (through the eternity of the eternities) we shall be with the Lord! Therefore comfort and encourage one another with these words.

BUT AS to the suitable times and the precise seasons and dates, brethren, you have no necessity for anything being written to you. ² For you yourselves know perfectly well that the day of the [return of the] Lord will come [as unexpectedly and suddenly] as a thief in the night. ⁴ But you are not in [given up to the power of] darkness, brethren, for that day to overtake you by surprise like a thief. AMP

1 Thessalonians 5 For God has not appointed us to [incur His] wrath [He did not select us to condemn us], but [that we might] obtain [His] salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) ¹⁰ Who died for us so that whether we are still alive or are dead [at Christ's appearing], we might live together with Him and share His life. AMP
