God says I'm doing a fresh new thing.....God said I am breaking the power of delay....new strength is coming, new strength for the journey that I'm taking you on.....I'm raising up those that will hold up your arms, I'm raising up those that will be faithful to the assignment says the Lord. I'm raising up those with the same DNA that is in you says the Lord. So God says I'm going to cause your eyes to be awakened in a new way. God said do not hold back for I say the best is in front of you, it is not behind you</u>.

## A Caleb Spirit

Numbers 13<sup>1</sup> The LORD now said to Moses, <sup>2</sup> "Send out men to explore the land of Canaan, the land I am giving to the Israelites. Send one leader from each of the twelve ancestral tribes." <sup>16b</sup> ... Moses called Hoshea son of Nun by the name Joshua. <sup>23</sup> When they came to the valley of Eshcol, they cut down a branch with a single cluster of grapes so large that it took two of them to carry it on a pole between them! They also brought back samples of the pomegranates and figs. <sup>25</sup> After exploring the land for **forty days**, the men returned <sup>26</sup> to Moses, Aaron, and the whole community of Israel at Kadesh in the wilderness of Paran. They reported to the whole community what they had seen and showed them the fruit they had taken from the land. <sup>27</sup> This was their report to Moses: "We entered the land you sent us to explore, and it is indeed a bountiful country-a land flowing with milk and honey. Here is the kind of fruit it produces. <sup>28</sup> But the people living there are powerful, and their towns are large and fortified. We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak! <sup>30</sup> But Caleb tried to quiet the people as they stood before Moses. "Let's go at once to take the land," he said. "We can certainly conquer it!" <sup>31</sup> But the other men who had explored the land with him disagreed. "We can't go up against them! They are stronger than we are!" <sup>32</sup> So they spread this bad report about the land among the Israelites: "The land we traveled through and explored will devour anyone who goes to live there. All the people we saw were huge. <sup>33</sup> We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak. Next to them we felt like grasshoppers, and that's what they thought, too!" NLT

**Numbers 14** <sup>1</sup> Then the whole community began weeping aloud, and they cried all night. <sup>2</sup> Their voices rose in a great chorus of protest against Moses and Aaron. "If only we had died in Egypt, or even here in the wilderness!" <u>they complained</u>. <sup>3</sup> "Why is the LORD taking us to this country only to have us die in battle? Our wives and our little ones will be carried off as plunder! Wouldn't it be better for us to return to Egypt?" <sup>4</sup> Then they plotted among themselves, "<u>Let's choose a new leader and go back to Egypt</u>!" <sup>5</sup> ...Joshua and Caleb... <sup>7</sup> <u>They said to all the people of Israel</u>, "The land we traveled through and explored is a wonderful land! <sup>8</sup> And if the LORD is pleased with us, <u>he will bring</u>

**us safely into that land and give it to us**. **It is a rich land flowing with milk and honey**. <sup>9</sup> Do not rebel against the LORD, and don't be afraid of the people of the land. They are only helpless prey to us! They have no protection, but <u>the LORD is with us</u>! <u>Don't be afraid of them</u>!" <sup>10</sup> But the whole community began to talk about stoning Joshua and Caleb. Then the glorious presence of the LORD appeared to all the Israelites at the Tabernacle. <sup>11</sup> And the <u>LORD said</u> to Moses, "<u>How long</u> will these people treat me with contempt? Will they never believe me, even after all the miraculous signs I have done among them</u>? <sup>20</sup> Then the LORD said, "<u>I will pardon them as you have requested</u>. <sup>21</sup> But as surely as I live, and as surely as the earth is filled with the LORD's glory, <sup>22</sup> not one of these people will ever enter that land... ...again and again they have tested me by refusing to listen to my voice. <sup>23</sup> ...None of those who have treated me with contempt will ever see it. <sup>24</sup> But my servant <u>Caleb has a different attitude</u> than the others have. He has remained loyal to me, so I will bring him into the land he explored. His descendants will possess their full share of that land. NLT

Joshua 14<sup>6b</sup>...Caleb said to Joshua, "Remember what the LORD said to Moses, the man of God, about you and me when we were at Kadesh-barnea. <sup>7</sup> I was forty years old when Moses, the servant of the LORD, sent me from Kadesh-barnea to explore the land of Canaan. I returned and gave an honest report, <sup>8</sup> but my brothers who went with me frightened the people from entering the Promised Land. For my part, I wholeheartedly followed the LORD my God. <sup>9</sup> So that day Moses solemnly promised me, 'The land of Canaan on which you were just walking will be your grant of land and that of your descendants forever, because you wholeheartedly followed the LORD my God.' <sup>10</sup> "Now, as you can see, the LORD has kept me alive and well as he promised for all these forty-five years since Moses made this promise-even while Israel wandered in the wilderness. Today I am eighty-five years old. <sup>11</sup> I am as strong now as I was when Moses sent me on that journey, and I can still travel and fight as well as I could then. <sup>12</sup> So give me the hill country that the LORD promised me. You will remember that as scouts we found the descendants of Anak living there in great, walled towns. But if the LORD is with me, I will drive them out of the land, just as the LORD said." <sup>13</sup> So Joshua blessed Caleb son of Jephunneh and gave Hebron to him as his portion of land.<sup>14</sup> Hebron still belongs to the descendants of Caleb son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite because he wholeheartedly followed the LORD, the God of Israel. <sup>15</sup>...And the land had rest from war.
