Romans 14 ¹⁷ For the **kingdom of God** is not a matter of rules about food and drink, but **is in the realm of the Holy Spirit, filled with righteousness, peace, and joy.** TPT ¹⁷ For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of what we eat or drink, but of **living a life of goodness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.** NLT ¹⁷ for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but **righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.** NASB

Nehemiah 8 ¹⁰ And Nehemiah continued, “**Go and celebrate with a feast** of rich foods and sweet drinks, and share gifts of food with people who have nothing prepared. This is a sacred day before our Lord. **Don’t be dejected and sad, for the joy of the LORD is your strength!**” NLT

John 15 ¹¹ I have told you these things **so that you will be filled with my joy.** Yes, **your joy will overflow!** NLT ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you **so that My joy may be in you,** and **that your joy may be made full.** NASB

John 16 ²⁴ Until now you’ve not been bold enough to ask the Father for a single thing in my name, but now you can **ask, and keep on asking him!** And you can be sure that you’ll receive what you ask for, and **your joy will have no limits!** TPT ²⁴ ...so that **your joy may be made full.** NASB

Mark 1 ¹⁵ His message was this: “**At last the fulfillment of the age has come! It is time for God’s kingdom to be experienced in its fullness!** Turn your lives back to God and put your trust in the hope-filled gospel!” TPT

Mark 16 ¹⁹ After saying these things, **Jesus was lifted up into heaven and sat down at the place of honor at the right hand of God!** ²⁰ And the apostles went out announcing the good news everywhere, as the Lord himself consistently worked with them, **validating the message they preached with miracle-signs that accompanied them!** TPT

Matthew 6 ³³ “**So above all, constantly seek God’s kingdom and his righteousness,** then all these less important things will be given to you abundantly. TPT

Luke 20 ⁴³ **until I humble your enemies, making them a footstool under your feet.**’ NLT

Acts 2 ³⁴ For David himself never ascended into heaven, yet he said, ‘The LORD said to my Lord, “**Sit in the place of honor at my right hand** ³⁵ **until I humble your enemies, making them a footstool under your feet.**”’ ³⁶ “So let everyone in Israel know for certain that **God has made this Jesus,** whom you crucified, to be both **Lord and Messiah!**” NLT

Psalms 110 ¹ **Yahweh said to my Lord, the Messiah: “Sit with me as enthroned ruler while I subdue your every enemy. They will bow low before you as I make them a footstool for your feet.”** ² **Messiah, I know God himself will establish your kingdom** as you reign in Zion-glory. For he says to you, “**Rule in the midst of your enemies!**” TPT

1 Corinthians 15 ²⁴ Then the final stage of completion comes, when he will bring to an end every other rulership, authority, and power, and he will hand over his kingdom to Father God. ²⁵ Until then he is destined to reign as King until all hostility has been subdued and placed under his feet. ²⁶ And the last enemy to be subdued and eliminated is death itself. TPT

Isaiah 9 ⁶ For a Child will be born to us, a Son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷ There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace on the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of armies will accomplish this. NASB ⁶ A child has been born for us; a son has been given to us. The responsibility of complete dominion will rest on his shoulders, and his name will be: The Wonderful One! The Extraordinary Strategist! The Mighty God! The Father of Eternity! The Prince of Peace! ⁷ Great and vast is his dominion. He will bring immeasurable peace and prosperity. He will rule on David's throne and over David's kingdom to establish and uphold it by promoting justice and righteousness from this time forward and forevermore. The marvelous passion that the Lord Yahweh, Commander of Angel Armies, has for his people will ensure that it is finished! TPT

Acts 3 ²⁰ And he will send you Jesus, the Messiah, the appointed one. ²¹ For he must remain in heaven until the restoration of all things has taken place, fulfilling everything that God said long ago through his holy prophets. TPT

Acts 3 ¹⁹ And now you must repent and turn back to God so that your sins will be removed, and so that times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence. ²⁰ And he will send you Jesus, the Messiah, the appointed one. ²¹ For he must remain in heaven until the restoration of all things has taken place, fulfilling everything that God said long ago through his holy prophets. TPT

Isaiah 10 ²⁷ In that day the Lord will remove the heavy burden from your shoulders and break off the yoke of bondage from your necks because of the heavy anointing upon you! TPT

1 John 2 ²⁰ But the Holy One has anointed you and you all know *the truth*. ²¹ So I'm writing to you not because you don't know the truth, but because you do know it, and no lie belongs to the truth. ²⁷ But the wonderful anointing you have received from God is so much greater than their deception and now lives in you. There's no need for anyone to keep teaching you. His anointing teaches you all that you need to know, for it will lead you into truth, not a counterfeit. So just as the anointing has taught you, remain in him. TPT

Romans 8 ¹ *So now the case is closed.* There remains no accusing voice of condemnation against those who are joined in life-union with Jesus, the Anointed One. ² For the "law" of the Spirit of life flowing through the anointing of Jesus has liberated us from the "law" of sin and death. TPT

Luke 18 ³⁵ As Jesus and his followers arrived at Jericho, a blind beggar was sitting by the roadside. ³⁶ When he heard the crowd approaching, he asked, "What's all this commotion about?" ³⁷ "It's Jesus!" they said. "Jesus the Nazarene is passing by." ³⁸ The blind beggar shouted, "Jesus, Son of David, have pity and show me mercy!" ³⁹ Those in the front of the crowd scolded him and warned him to be quiet, but the blind beggar screamed out even louder, "Jesus, Son of David, show me mercy!" ⁴⁰ Suddenly Jesus stopped and directed those nearby, "Bring the man over to me." When they brought him before Jesus, he asked the man, ⁴¹ "What do you want me to do for you?" "Master," he said, "please, I want to see." ⁴² Jesus said, "Now you will see. Receive your sight this moment, for your faith in me has given you sight and new life." TPT
