

## THE KINGDOM OF GOD AND HIS ANOINTINGS ARE HERE AND ALWAYS GROWING

**Romans 14** <sup>17</sup> For the <u>kingdom of God</u> is not a matter of rules about food and drink, but <u>is in the</u> <u>realm of the Holy Spirit</u>, <u>filled with righteousness</u>, <u>peace</u>, <u>and <u>joy</u></u>. *TPT* <sup>17</sup> For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of what we eat or drink, but of <u>living a life of goodness and peace and <u>joy</u> in <u>the Holy Spirit</u>. *NLT* <sup>17</sup> for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but <u>righteousness</u> <u>and peace and joy</u> in the Holy Spirit</u>. NASB

**Nehemiah 8** <sup>10</sup> And Nehemiah continued, "<u>Go and celebrate with a feast</u> of rich foods and sweet drinks, and share gifts of food with people who have nothing prepared. This is a sacred day before our Lord. <u>Don't be dejected and sad</u>, <u>for the *joy* of the LORD is your strength</u>!" NLT

John 15 <sup>11</sup> I have told you these things <u>so that you will be filled with my *joy*</u>. Yes, <u>your *joy* will</u> <u>overflow</u>! NLT <sup>11</sup> These things I have spoken to you <u>so that My *joy* may be in you</u>, and <u>that your *joy* may be made full</u>. NASB

**John 16** <sup>24</sup> Until now you've not been bold enough to ask the Father for a single thing in my name, but now you can <u>ask</u>, <u>and keep on asking him</u>! And you can be sure that you'll receive what you ask for, and <u>your *joy* will have no limits</u>! TPT <sup>24</sup> ...so that <u>your *joy* may be made full</u>. NASB

Mark 1 <sup>15</sup> His message was this: "<u>At last the fulfillment of the age has come</u>! <u>It is time for God's</u> <u>kingdom to be experienced in its fullness</u>! Turn your lives back to God and put your trust in the hope-filled gospel!" TPT

Mark 16 <sup>19</sup> After saying these things, <u>Jesus was lifted up into heaven and sat down at the place</u> <u>of honor at the right hand of God</u>! <sup>20</sup> And the apostles went out announcing the good news everywhere, as the Lord himself consistently worked with them, <u>validating the message they</u> <u>preached with miracle-signs that accompanied them</u>! TPT

Matthew 6 <sup>33</sup> "<u>So above all</u>, <u>constantly seek God's kingdom and his righteousness</u>, then all these less important things will be given to you abundantly. TPT

Luke 20<sup>43</sup> until I humble your enemies, making them a footstool under your feet.' NLT

Acts 2 <sup>34</sup> For David himself never ascended into heaven, yet he said, 'The LORD said to my Lord, "<u>Sit in the place of honor at my right hand</u> <sup>35</sup> <u>until I humble your enemies</u>, <u>making them a</u> <u>footstool under your feet</u>."<sup>36</sup> "So let everyone in Israel know for certain that <u>God has made this</u> <u>Jesus</u>, whom you crucified, to be both <u>Lord and Messiah</u>!" NLT

Psalm 110 <sup>1</sup> Yahweh said to my Lord, the Messiah: "Sit with me as enthroned ruler while I subdue your every enemy. They will bow low before you as I make them a footstool for your feet." <sup>2</sup> Messiah, I know God himself will establish your kingdom as you reign in Zion-glory. For he says to you, "Rule in the midst of your enemies!" TPT

**1 Corinthians 15** <sup>24</sup> <u>Then the final stage of completion comes</u>, when he will bring to an end every other rulership, authority, and power, and he will hand over his kingdom to Father God. <sup>25</sup> <u>Until then he is destined to reign as *King* until all hostility has been subdued and placed under his <u>feet</u>. <sup>26</sup> And the last enemy to be subdued and eliminated is death itself. TPT</u>

**Isaiah 9** <sup>6</sup> For a Child will be born to us, a Son will be given to us; And <u>the government will rest on</u> <u>His shoulders</u>: And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. <sup>7</sup> <u>There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace on the throne of David and over his kingdom, <u>To establish it and to uphold it with justice and</u> <u>righteousness From then on and forevermore</u>. The zeal of the LORD of armies will accomplish this. NASB <sup>6</sup> A child has been born for us; a son has been given to us. <u>The responsibility</u> <u>of complete dominion will rest on his shoulders</u>, and his name will be: The Wonderful One! The Extraordinary Strategist! The Mighty God! The Father of Eternity! The Prince of Peace! <sup>7</sup> <u>Great and</u> <u>vast is his dominion</u>. <u>He will bring immeasurable peace and prosperity</u>. He will rule on David's throne and over David's kingdom to establish and uphold it by promoting justice and righteousness <u>from this time forward and forevermore</u>. <u>The marvelous passion that the Lord Yahweh</u>, <u>Commander of Angel Armies</u>, <u>has for his people will ensure that it is finished</u>! TPT</u>

Acts 3 <sup>20</sup> And he will send you Jesus, the Messiah, the appointed one. <sup>21</sup> For he must remain in heaven until the restoration of all things has taken place, *fulfilling everything that God* said long ago through his holy prophets. TPT

Acts 3 <sup>19</sup> And now you must repent and turn back to God so that your sins will be removed, and <u>so</u> that <u>times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence</u>. <sup>20</sup> And he will send you Jesus, the Messiah, the appointed one. <sup>21</sup> For he must remain in heaven until the restoration of all things has taken place, <u>fulfilling everything that God said long ago through his holy</u> prophets. TPT

**Isaiah 10** <sup>27</sup> In that day the Lord will remove the heavy burden from your shoulders and <u>break off</u> the yoke of bondage from your necks because of the <u>heavy anointing upon you</u>! TPT

**1** John 2 <sup>20</sup> But <u>the Holy One has anointed you</u> and you all know *the truth*. <sup>21</sup> So I'm writing to you not because you don't know the truth, but because you do know it, and no lie belongs to the truth. <sup>27</sup> But <u>the wonderful anointing you have received from God</u> is so much greater than their *deception and* now lives in you. There's no need for anyone to keep teaching you. <u>His anointing teaches you</u> all that you need to know, for it will lead you into truth, not a counterfeit. So just as <u>the anointing</u> has taught you, remain in him. TPT

**Romans 8** <sup>1</sup> So now the case is closed. There remains no accusing voice of condemnation against those who are joined in life-union with Jesus, the Anointed One. <sup>2</sup> For the "law" of the Spirit of life flowing through the anointing of Jesus has liberated us from the "law" of sin and death. TPT

**Luke 18** <sup>35</sup> As Jesus and his followers arrived at Jericho, a blind beggar was sitting by the roadside. <sup>36</sup> When he heard the crowd approaching, he asked, "What's all this commotion about?" <sup>37</sup> "It's Jesus!" they said. "Jesus the Nazarene is passing by." <sup>38</sup> The blind beggar shouted, "Jesus, <u>Son of David</u>, <u>have pity and show me mercy</u>!" <sup>39</sup> Those in the front of the crowd scolded him and warned him to be quiet, but the blind beggar screamed out even louder, "Jesus, <u>Son of David</u>, <u>show me mercy</u>!" <sup>40</sup> Suddenly Jesus stopped and directed those nearby, "Bring the man over to me." When they brought him before Jesus, he asked the man, <sup>41</sup> "<u>What do you want me to do for you</u>?" "Master," he said, "please, I want to see." <sup>42</sup> Jesus said, "Now you will see. Receive your sight this moment, <u>for your faith in me has given you sight and new life</u>." TPT
