**Romans 1** <sup>21</sup> Yes, they knew God, but **they wouldn't worship him as God or even give him thanks.** And they began to think up **foolish ideas of what God was like.** As a result, their minds became dark and confused. <sup>22</sup> **Claiming to be wise, they instead became utter fools.** <sup>23</sup> And instead of worshiping the glorious, ever-living God, they worshiped idols made to look like mere people and birds and animals and reptiles. NLT

**3 John 2** <sup>2</sup> Beloved friend, **I pray that you are prospering in every way** and that you continually enjoy good health, just as your soul is prospering. TPT

**1 Timothy 6** <sup>10</sup> **For the love of money is the root of all kinds of evil.** And some people, craving money, have **wandered from the true faith** and pierced themselves with many sorrows. NLT

**Deuteronomy 8** <sup>17</sup> He did all this so you would never say to yourself, 'I have achieved this wealth with my own strength and energy.' <sup>18</sup> Remember the LORD your God. **He is the one who gives you power to be successful,** in order to fulfill the covenant he confirmed to your ancestors with an oath. <sup>19</sup> "But I assure you of this: If you ever forget the LORD your God and follow other gods, worshiping and bowing down to them, you will certainly be destroyed. NLT

**Psalms 112** <sup>1</sup> Shout in celebration of praise to the Lord! **Everyone who loves the Lord** and delights in him will cherish his words and be blessed beyond expectation. <sup>2</sup> **Their descendants will be prosperous and influential.** Every generation of the righteous will experience his favor. <sup>3</sup> **Great blessing and wealth fills the house of the wise, for their integrity endures forever.** TPT

**1 Kings 3** <sup>5</sup> That night the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream, and **God said, "What do you want? Ask, and I will give it to you!"** <sup>6</sup> Solomon replied, "You showed great and faithful love to your servant my father, David, because he was honest and true and faithful to you. And you have continued to show this great and faithful love to him today by giving him a son to sit on his throne. <sup>7</sup> "Now, O LORD my God, you have made me king instead of my father, David, but I am like a little child who doesn't know his way around. <sup>8</sup> And here I am in the midst of your own chosen people, a nation so great and numerous they cannot be counted! <sup>9</sup> **Give me an understanding heart so that I can govern your people well and know the difference between right and wrong.** For who by himself is able to govern this great people of yours?" <sup>10</sup> **The Lord was pleased that Solomon had asked for wisdom.** <sup>11</sup> So God replied, "**Because you have asked for wisdom** in governing my people with justice and have not asked for a long life or wealth or the death of your enemies— <sup>12</sup> **I will give you what you asked for!** I will give you a wise and understanding heart such as no one else has had or ever will have! <sup>13</sup> **And I will also give you what you did not ask for—riches and fame!** No other king in all the world will be compared to you for the rest of your life! <sup>14</sup> And if you follow me and obey my decrees and my commands as your father, David, did, I will give you a long life." NLT

**Proverbs 3** <sup>16</sup> **Wisdom extends to you long life in one hand and wealth and promotion in the other.** Out of her mouth flows righteousness, and her words release both law and mercy. TPT

**1 Corinthians 1** <sup>30</sup> *For it is not from man that we draw our life but from God as we are being joined to Jesus, the Anointed One. And now he is our God-given wisdom, our virtue, our holiness, and our redemption. TPT*

**Ephesians 1** <sup>16</sup> my heart is always full and overflowing with thanks to God for you as I constantly remember you in my prayers. <sup>17</sup> I pray that the Father of glory, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, would impart to you the riches of the *Spirit of wisdom and the Spirit of revelation to know him through your deepening intimacy with him.* <sup>18</sup> I pray that the light of God will illuminate the eyes of your imagination, flooding you with light, until you experience the full revelation of the hope of his calling—that is, the wealth of God’s glorious inheritances that he finds in us, his holy ones! <sup>19</sup> I pray that you will continually experience the immeasurable greatness of God’s power made available to you through faith. Then your lives will be an advertisement of this immense power as it works through you! This is the mighty power <sup>20</sup> that was released when God raised Christ from the dead and exalted him to the place of highest honor and supreme authority in the heavenly realm! <sup>21</sup> And now he is exalted as first above every ruler, authority, government, and realm of power in existence! He is gloriously enthroned over every name that is ever praised, not only in this age, but in the age that is coming! <sup>22</sup> And he alone is the leader and source of everything needed in the church. God has put everything beneath the authority of Jesus Christ and has given him the highest rank above all others. <sup>23</sup> And now we, his church, are his body on the earth and that which fills him who is being filled by it! TPT

**Deuteronomy 34** <sup>7</sup> Moses was 120 years old when he died, yet his eyesight was clear, and he was as strong as ever. <sup>9</sup> Now Joshua son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him. So the people of Israel obeyed him, doing just as the LORD had commanded Moses. NLT

**2 Timothy 1** <sup>6</sup> I’m writing to encourage you to fan into a flame and rekindle the fire of the spiritual gift God imparted to you when I laid my hands upon you. <sup>7</sup> For God will never give you the spirit of fear, but the Holy Spirit who gives you mighty power, love, and self-control. TPT

**Hebrews 6** <sup>2</sup> teaching about different baptisms, impartation by the laying on of hands, resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment. TPT

**1 Timothy 4** <sup>14</sup> Don’t minimize the powerful gift that operates in your life, for it was imparted to you by the laying on of hands of the elders and was activated through the prophecy they spoke over you. <sup>15</sup> Make all of this your constant meditation and make it real with your life so everyone can see that you are moving forward. <sup>16</sup> Give careful attention to your spiritual life and every cherished truth you teach, for living what you preach will release salvation inside you and to all those who listen to you. TPT - <sup>4:14</sup> Do not neglect the spiritual gift you received through the prophecy spoken over you when the elders of the church laid their hands on you. <sup>15a</sup> Give your complete attention to these matters. NLT

**Proverbs 10** <sup>22</sup> The blessing of the LORD makes a person rich, and he adds no sorrow with it. NLT

**Proverbs 13** <sup>22</sup> Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner’s wealth passes to the godly. NLT

**2 Corinthians 8** <sup>9</sup> You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that by his poverty he could make you rich. NLT
