



# Jesus Christ, Our Passover & Resurrection

## God can resurrect what is dead in our lives!

**Acts 10** <sup>1</sup>...a Roman military officer, Cornelius, who was in charge of one hundred men. <sup>2</sup> a devout man of extraordinary character who worshiped God and prayed regularly, together with all his family. He also had a heart for the poor and gave generously to help them. <sup>3</sup> ...he had an open vision and saw the angel of God appear right in front of him, calling out his name, "**Cornelius!**"... "**All of your prayers and your generosity to the poor have ascended before God as an eternal offering.**" <sup>31</sup> "**Cornelius, God has heard your prayers. Your generosity to the poor has been recorded and remembered in God's presence.**" <sup>34</sup> Peter said, "Now I know for certain that God doesn't show favoritism with people <sup>35</sup> **It makes no difference what race of people one belongs to. If they show deep reverence for God, and are committed to doing what's right, they are acceptable before him.**" <sup>38</sup> "**Jesus of Nazareth was anointed by God with the Holy Spirit and with great power. He did wonderful things for others and divinely healed all who were under the tyranny of the devil,**" <sup>39</sup> We apostles were eyewitnesses to all the miracles <sup>40</sup> **but God raised him from the dead three days later, allowing him to be seen openly.** <sup>43</sup> And not only us, but all of the prophets agree in their writings that **everyone who believes in him receives complete forgiveness.** TPT

**Deuteronomy 16** <sup>16</sup> "**Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses, at the Feast of Unleavened Bread (Passover) and at the Feast of Weeks (Pentecost) and at the Feast of Booths (Tabernacles), and they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed.**" <sup>17</sup> **Every man shall give as he is able, in accordance with the blessing which the LORD your God has given you.** AMP

**1 Corinthians 5** <sup>7</sup> Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are *in fact* unleavened. **For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.** <sup>8</sup> **Therefore let's celebrate the feast...** NASB

**Psalm 105** <sup>37</sup> **He also brought them out with silver and gold,** And *there was* none feeble among His tribes. NKJ

**Malachi 3** <sup>7b</sup> ...**Return to Me, and I will return to you,**" says the LORD of hosts. "But you say, '**How shall we return?**'" <sup>8</sup> "**Will a man rob God?** Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings [you have withheld]." <sup>9</sup> You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing Me, this whole nation! <sup>10</sup> **Bring all the tithes (the tenth)** into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, **and test Me now in this,**" says the LORD of hosts, "if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you [so great] a blessing until there is no more room to receive it. <sup>16</sup> Then those who feared the LORD [with awe-filled reverence] spoke to one another; and **the LORD paid attention and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before Him of those who fear the LORD** [with an attitude of reverence and respect] **and who esteem His name.**" <sup>17</sup> "They will be Mine," says the LORD of hosts, "on that day when I publicly recognize them *and* openly declare them to be My own possession [that is, My very special treasure]..." <sup>18</sup> **Then you will again distinguish between the righteous and the wicked,** between the one who serves God and the one who does not serve Him. AMP

**Genesis 45** <sup>10</sup> You can live in the region of Goshen... NLT

**Exodus 8** <sup>22</sup> But this time I will spare the region of Goshen, where my people live. No flies will be found there. Then you will know that I am the LORD and that I am present even in the heart of your land. <sup>23</sup> I will make a clear distinction between my people and your people... NLT

**Exodus 9** <sup>2</sup> If you continue to hold them and refuse to let them go, <sup>3</sup> the hand of the LORD will strike all your livestock—your horses, donkeys, camels, cattle, sheep, and goats—with a deadly plague. <sup>4</sup> But the LORD will again make a distinction between the livestock of the Israelites and that of the Egyptians. Not a single one of Israel's animals will die! <sup>7</sup> Pharaoh sent his officials to investigate, and they discovered that the Israelites had not lost a single animal!... <sup>26</sup> The only place without hail was the region of Goshen, where the people of Israel lived. NLT

**John 11** <sup>21</sup> Martha said to Jesus, “My Lord, if only you had come sooner, my brother wouldn't have died. <sup>22</sup> But I know that if you were to ask God for anything, he would do it for you.” <sup>23</sup> Jesus told her, “Your brother will rise and live.” <sup>24</sup> She replied, “Yes, I know he will rise with everyone else on resurrection day.” <sup>25</sup> “Martha,” Jesus said, “You don't have to wait until then. I am the Resurrection, and I am Life Eternal. Anyone who clings to me in faith, even though he dies, will live forever. <sup>26</sup> And the one who lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?” <sup>27</sup> Then Martha replied, “Yes, Lord, I do! I've always believed that you are the Anointed One, the Son of God who has come into the world for us!” TPT

**1 John 4** <sup>15</sup> Those who give thanks that Jesus is the Son of God live in God, and God lives in them. <sup>16</sup> We have come into an intimate experience with God's love, and we trust in the love he has for us.
