God Loves You

3 John 1 ² Beloved friend, I pray that you are prospering in every way and that you continually enjoy good health, just as your soul is prospering. TPT

1 John 4 ⁷ Those who are loved by God, let his love continually pour from you to one another, because **God is love**. Everyone who loves is fathered by God and experiences an intimate knowledge of him. ⁸ The one who doesn't love has yet to know God, for **God is love**. ⁹ The light of God's love shined within us when he sent his matchless Son into the world so that we might live through him. ¹⁰ **This is love: He loved us long before we loved him. It was his love, not ours. He proved it by sending his Son to be the pleasing sacrificial offering to take away our sins.** ¹¹ **Delightfully loved ones**, if he loved us with such tremendous love, then "loving one another" should be our way of life! TPT

John 3 ¹⁶ **For here is the way God loved the world—he gave his only, unique Son as a gift. So now everyone who believes in him will never perish but experience everlasting life.** ¹⁷ "God did not send his Son into the world to judge and condemn the world, but to be its Savior and rescue it! ¹⁸ So now there is no longer any condemnation for those who believe in him... TPT

2 Peter 3 ^{9b} ...because he does not want any to perish but all to come to repentance. TPT

John 15 ⁹ **"I love each of you with the same love that the Father loves me. You must continually let my love nourish your hearts.** TPT

Genesis 1 ^{26a} Then God said, **"Let us make human in our image, to be like us..."** ²⁷ So God created human in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. ^{28a} **Then God blessed them** and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it. NLT

Matthew 22 ³⁷ Jesus replied, **"You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.** ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ A second is equally important: **'Love your neighbor as yourself.'** NLT

Nothing Too Hard

Jeremiah 32 ¹⁷ **"O Sovereign LORD! You made the heavens and earth by your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for you!"** ²⁷ "I am the LORD, the God of all the peoples of the world. **Is anything too hard for me?** NLT

Ephesians 3 ²⁰ *Never doubt* God's mighty power to work in you and accomplish all this. **He will achieve infinitely more than your greatest request, your most unbelievable dream, and exceed your wildest imagination!** He will outdo them all, for his miraculous power constantly energizes you. TPT

Mark 10 ²⁷ Jesus looked at them intently and said, "Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But not with God. **Everything is possible with God.**" TPT

Luke 1 ³⁷ Not one promise from God is empty of power. **Nothing is impossible with God!**" TPT

Mark 9 ²³ **Jesus said to him, "What do you mean 'if'? If you are able to believe, all things are possible to the believer."** TPT

2 Kings 6 ¹⁴ So one night the king of Aram sent a great army with many chariots and horses to surround the city. ¹⁵ When the servant of the man of God got up early the next morning and went outside, there were troops, horses, and chariots everywhere. "Oh, sir, what will we do now?" the young man cried to

Elisha. ¹⁶ **“Don’t be afraid!” Elisha told him. “For there are more on our side than on theirs!”**
¹⁷ Then Elisha prayed, “O LORD, open his eyes and let him see!” **The LORD opened the young man’s eyes, and when he looked up, he saw that the hillside around Elisha was filled with horses and chariots of fire.** NLT

Hebrews 1 ¹³ And God has never said this to any of his angels: “Take your seat next to me at my right hand until I force your whispering enemies to be a rug under your feet.” ¹⁴ **What role then, do the angels have? The angels are spirit-messengers sent by God to serve those who are going to be saved.** TPT

Psalms 103 ²⁰ So bless the Lord, all his messengers of power, for **you are his mighty heroes who listen intently to the voice of his word to do it.** ²¹ Bless and praise the Lord, you mighty warriors, ministers who serve him well and fulfill his desires. ²² I will bless and praise the Lord with my whole heart! Let all his works throughout the earth, wherever his dominion stretches—let everything bless the Lord! TPT

He Hears You

James 4 ² ...**And all the time you don’t obtain what you want because you won’t ask God for it!** TPT

1 John 5 ¹³ I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life. ¹⁴ **And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him.** ¹⁵ **And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for.** TPT

John 15 ⁷ But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, **you may ask for anything you want,** and it will be granted! TPT

Matthew 7 ⁷ “Ask, and the gift is yours. Seek, and you’ll discover. Knock, and the door will be opened for you. ⁸ **For every persistent one will get what he asks for.** Every persistent seeker will discover what he longs for. And **everyone who knocks persistently will one day find an open door.** TPT

Matthew 6 ⁹ Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy. ¹⁰ **May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.** TPT

Why Worry?

Psalms 55 ²² **Give your burdens to the LORD, and he will take care of you.** He will not permit the godly to slip and fall. ²³ But you, O God, will send the wicked down to the pit of destruction... TPT

1 Peter 5 ⁷ **Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.** TPT
NOTE: Or “Load upon him your every anxiety, for he is always watching over you with tender care.”

Philippians 4 ⁶ **Don’t worry about anything; instead, pray about everything.** Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. ⁷ Then you will experience God’s peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. TPT

2 Corinthians 10 ³⁻⁴ For although we live in the natural realm, we don’t wage a military campaign employing human weapons, *using manipulation to achieve our aims*. Instead, our *spiritual* weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses *behind which people hide*. ⁵ We can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. **We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One.** TPT

Romans 8 ²⁸ **So we are convinced that every detail of our lives is continually woven together for good, for we are his lovers who have been called to fulfill his designed purpose.** TPT
