Joshua 24 ¹⁴ **“So fear the Lord and serve him wholeheartedly. ...¹⁵ But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord.”** NLT

Hebrews 11 ⁶ And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that **he rewards those who sincerely seek him.** NLT

Ephesians 2 ⁸ For by grace you have been saved by faith. Nothing you did could ever earn this salvation, for it was the love gift from God that brought us to Christ! ⁹ So no one will ever be able to boast, **for salvation is never a reward for good works or human striving.** ¹⁰ We have become his poetry, a re-created people that will fulfill the **destiny** he has given each of us, for we are joined to Jesus, the Anointed One. Even before we were born, **God planned in advance our destiny and the good works we would do to fulfill it!** TPT

Pray In Tongues

1 Corinthians 3 ¹¹ For no one can lay any **foundation** other than the one we already have—**Jesus Christ.** ¹² Anyone who **builds on that foundation** may use a variety of materials—**gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw.** ¹³ **But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person’s work has any value.** ¹⁴ If the work survives, that builder will receive a **reward.** ¹⁵ But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames. NLT

2 Corinthians 5 ⁹ **So whether we live or die we make it our life’s passion to live our lives pleasing to him.** ¹⁰ For one day we will all be openly revealed before Christ on his throne so that each of us will be duly **recompensed** for our actions done in life, **whether good or worthless.** TPT

Psalms 127 ³ **Children are God’s love-gift; they are heaven’s generous reward.** ⁴ Children born to a young couple will one day rise to protect and provide for their parents. ⁵ Happy will be the couple who has many of them! A household full of children will not bring shame on your name but victory when you face your enemies, for **your offspring will have influence and honor to prevail on your behalf!** TPT

Isaiah 49 ²⁵ But Yahweh says: “The prey will be freed from the mighty warrior and captives will be rescued from a conqueror! **For I will fight with those who fight with you, and I myself will save your children.** TPT

Isaiah 54 ¹⁰ Even if the mountains were to crumble and the hills disappear, my heart of steadfast, faithful love will never leave you, and my covenant of peace with you will never be shaken,” says **Yahweh, whose love and compassion will never give up on you.** ¹¹ “You unhappy one, storm-tossed and troubled, I am ready to rebuild you with precious stones and embed your foundation with sapphires. ... ¹³ **All your children will be taught by Yahweh, and great will be their peace and prosperity.** ¹⁴ You will be established in righteousness. Oppression—be far from them! Fear—be far from them! Yes, terror will not come near you, nor will you be afraid. ¹⁵ If anyone dares to stir up strife against you, it is not from me! Those who challenge you will go down in defeat. ... ¹⁷ **But I promise you, no weapon meant to hurt you will succeed, and you will refute every accusing word spoken against you. This promise is the inheritance of Yahweh’s servants, and their vindication is from me,**” says Yahweh. TPT

Acts 7 ^{32a} **‘I am the living God, the God of your ancestors. I am the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.’** TPT

Matthew 25 ²³ “The master said, **‘Well done, my good and faithful servant.** You have been faithful in handling this small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. Let’s celebrate together!” NLT

Proverbs 13 ²² **The benevolent man leaves an inheritance that endures to his children’s children, but the wealth of the wicked is treasured up for the righteous.** ²³ **The lovers of God will live a long life and get to enjoy their wealth,** but the ungodly will suddenly perish. TPT

Psalms 112 ¹ Shout in celebration of praise to the Lord! **Everyone who loves the Lord and delights in him will cherish his words and be blessed beyond expectation.** ² **Their descendants will be prosperous and influential. Every generation of the righteous will experience his favor.** ³ Great blessing and wealth fills the house of the wise, for **their integrity endures forever.** TPT

Psalms 68 ⁵⁻⁶ **To the fatherless he is a father.** To the widow he is a champion friend. **The lonely he makes part of a family.** The prisoners he leads into prosperity until they sing for joy. This is our Holy God in his Holy Place! TPT

Hebrews 6 ¹⁰ For God, the Faithful One, is not unfair. How can he forget the *beautiful* work you have done for him? He remembers the love you demonstrate as you continually serve his beloved ones for the glory of his name. ¹¹ But we long to see you passionately advance until the end and you find your hope fulfilled. ¹² So don’t allow your hearts to grow dull or lose your enthusiasm, but **follow the example of those who fully received what God has promised because of their strong faith and patient endurance.** TPT

Matthew 6 ²⁰ Instead, **stockpile heavenly treasures for yourselves** that cannot be stolen and will never rust, decay, or lose their value. ²¹ **For your heart will always pursue what you esteem as your treasure.** TPT
