John 10 ⁹ Yes, I am the gate. Those who come in through me will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures. ¹⁰ The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life. NLT

Isaiah 22 ²² ...When he opens doors, no one will be able to close them; when he closes doors, no one will be able to open them. NLT

Proverbs 4 ¹⁸ But the lovers of God walk on the highway of light, and their way shines brighter and brighter until the perfect day. TPT

Acts 3 ¹⁹ And now you must repent and turn back to God so that your sins will be removed, and so that times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence. ²⁰ And he will send you Jesus, the Messiah, the appointed one. ²¹ For he must remain in heaven until the restoration of all things has taken place, fulfilling everything that God said long ago through his holy prophets. TPT

Luke 11 ⁹⁻¹⁰ So it is with your prayers. Ask and you'll receive. Seek and you'll discover. Knock on heaven's door, and it will one day open for you. Every persistent person will receive what he asks for. Every persistent seeker will discover what he needs. And everyone who knocks persistently will one day find an open door. TPT

1 Corinthians 16 ⁹ There's an amazing door of opportunity standing wide open for me to minister here, even though there are many who oppose and stand against me. TPT

Numbers 13 ¹ The Lord now said to Moses, ² "Send out men to explore the land of Canaan, the land I am giving to the Israelites. Send one leader from each of the twelve ancestral tribes." ³ So Moses did as the Lord commanded him. He sent out twelve men, all tribal leaders of Israel, from their camp in the wilderness of Paran... ¹⁶ These are the names of the men Moses sent out to explore the land. (Moses called Hoshea son of Nun by the name Joshua.) ¹⁷ Moses gave the men these instructions as he sent them out to explore the land: "Go north through the Negev into the hill country. ¹⁸ See what the land is like, and find out whether the people living there are strong or weak, few or many. ¹⁹ See what kind of land they live in. Is it good or bad? Do their towns have walls, or are they unprotected like open camps? ²⁰ Is the soil fertile or poor? Are there many trees? Do your best to bring back samples of the crops you see." (It happened to be the season for harvesting the first ripe grapes.)...²³ When they came to the valley of Eshcol, they cut down a branch with a single cluster of grapes so large that it took two of them to carry it on a pole between them! They also brought back samples of the

pomegranates and figs. ²⁴ That place was called the valley of Eshcol (which means “cluster”), because of the cluster of grapes the Israelite men cut there. ²⁵ After exploring the land for forty days, the men returned ²⁶ to Moses, Aaron, and the whole community of Israel at Kadesh in the wilderness of Paran. They reported to the whole community what they had seen and showed them the fruit they had taken from the land. ²⁷ **This was their report to Moses: “We entered the land you sent us to explore, and it is indeed a bountiful country—a land flowing with milk and honey. Here is the kind of fruit it produces.”** ²⁸ **But the people living there are powerful, and their towns are large and fortified. We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak!** ²⁹ The Amalekites live in the Negev, and the Hittites, Jebusites, and Amorites live in the hill country. The Canaanites live along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea and along the Jordan Valley.” ³⁰ **But Caleb tried to quiet the people as they stood before Moses. “Let’s go at once to take the land,” he said. “We can certainly conquer it!”** ³¹ But the other men who had explored the land with him disagreed. **“We can’t go up against them! They are stronger than we are!”** ³² **So they spread this bad report about the land among the Israelites:** “The land we traveled through and explored will devour anyone who goes to live there. All the people we saw were huge. ³³ We even saw giants there, the descendants of Anak. Next to them we felt like grasshoppers, and that’s what they thought, too!” NLT

Joshua 1 ¹ After the death of Moses the Lord’s servant, the Lord spoke to Joshua son of Nun, Moses’ assistant. He said, ² **“Moses my servant is dead. Therefore, the time has come for you to lead these people, the Israelites, across the Jordan River into the land I am giving them.”** ³ **I promise you what I promised Moses: ‘Wherever you set foot, you will be on land I have given you’—** ⁴ from the Negev wilderness in the south to the Lebanon mountains in the north, from the Euphrates River in the east to the Mediterranean Sea in the west, including all the land of the Hittites.’ ⁵ **No one will be able to stand against you as long as you live. For I will be with you as I was with Moses. I will not fail you or abandon you.** ⁶ **“Be strong and courageous,** for you are the one who will lead these people to **possess all the land I swore to their ancestors I would give them.** ⁷ **Be strong and very courageous.** Be careful to obey all the instructions Moses gave you. Do not deviate from them, turning either to the right or to the left. **Then you will be successful in everything you do.** ⁸ **Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night** so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. **Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.** ⁹ This is my command—**be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.**” NLT

Hebrews 6 ¹² So don’t allow your hearts to grow dull or lose your enthusiasm, but **follow the example of those who fully received what God has promised because of their strong faith and patient endurance.** TPT

Proverbs 13 ²² The benevolent man leaves an inheritance that endures to his children’s children, but **the wealth of the wicked is treasured up for the righteous.** TPT

Isaiah 60 ² **Darkness as black as night covers all the nations of the earth, but the glory of the Lord rises and appears over you...** ⁵ Your eyes will shine, and your heart will thrill with joy, for merchants from around the world will come to you. They will bring you the wealth of many lands... ¹¹ **Your gates will stay open day and night to receive the wealth of many lands.** The kings of the world will be led as captives in a victory procession. NLT
