



“WITHOUT ME YOU CAN DO NOTHING”

With Him You Can Change Generations To Come

John 15 ⁴ So you must remain in life-union with me, for I remain in life-union with you. For as a branch severed from the vine will not bear fruit, so your life will be fruitless unless you live your life intimately joined to mine. ⁵ “I am the sprouting vine and you’re my branches. As you live in union with me as your source, fruitfulness will stream from within you—but when you live separated from me you are powerless. ⁶ If a person is separated from me, he is discarded; such branches are gathered up and thrown into the fire to be burned. ⁷ But if you live in life-union with me and if my words live powerfully within you—then you can ask whatever you desire and it will be done. ⁸ When your lives bear abundant fruit, you demonstrate that you are my mature disciples who glorify my Father! TPT

If you can do nothing without Him then ask for His help in everything.

Ephesians 2 ⁷ So God can point to us in all future ages as examples of the incredible wealth of his grace and kindness toward us, as shown in all he has done for us who are united with Christ Jesus. ⁸ God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can’t take credit for this; it is a gift from God. ⁹ Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. ¹⁰ For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. NLT

Jeremiah 29 ¹¹ Here’s what Yahweh says to you: “I know all about the marvelous destiny I have in store for you, a future planned out in detail. My intention is not to harm you but to surround you with peace and prosperity and to give you a beautiful future, glistening with hope. ¹² When you call on me and come to me in prayer, I will listen to your every word. TPT

Deuteronomy 30 ¹⁵ “Now listen! Today I am giving you a choice between life and death, between prosperity and disaster. ¹⁶ For I command you this day to love the Lord your God and to keep his commands, decrees, and regulations by walking in his ways. If you do this, you will live and multiply, and the Lord your God will bless you and the land you are about to enter and occupy. ¹⁷ “But if your heart turns away and you refuse to listen, and if you are drawn away to serve and worship other gods, ¹⁸ then I warn you now that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live a long, good life in the land you are crossing the Jordan to occupy. ¹⁹ “Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! ²⁰ You can make this choice by loving the Lord your God, obeying him, and committing yourself firmly to him. This is the key to your life. And if you love and obey the Lord, you will live long in the land the Lord swore to give your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.” NLT

Isaiah 49 ²⁵ But Yahweh says: “The prey will be freed from the mighty warrior, and captives will be rescued from a conqueror! For I will fight with those who fight with you, and I myself will save your children. TPT

Isaiah 54 ¹³ All your children will be taught by Yahweh, and great will be their peace and prosperity. ¹⁴ You will be established in righteousness. Oppression—be far from you! Fear—be far from you! Yes, terror will not come near you, nor will you be afraid. ¹⁷ But I promise you, no weapon meant to hurt you will succeed, and you will refute every accusing word spoken against you. This

promise is the inheritance of Yahweh's servants, and their vindication is from me," says Yahweh. TPT

Proverbs 13 ¹⁸ Poverty and disgrace come to the one who refuses to hear criticism. But the one who is easy to correct is on the path of honor. ¹⁹ When God fulfills your longings, sweetness fills your soul. But the wicked refuse to turn from darkness *to see their desires come to pass.* ²⁰ If you want to grow in wisdom, spend time with the wise. Walk with the wicked and you'll eventually become just like them. ²¹ Calamity chases the sin-chaser, but prosperity pursues the God-lover. ²² The benevolent man leaves an inheritance that endures to his children's children, but the wealth of the wicked is treasured up for the righteous. ²³ The lovers of God will live a long life and get to enjoy their wealth, but the ungodly will suddenly perish. TPT

Proverbs 3 ¹¹ My child, when the Lord God speaks to you, never take his words lightly, and never be upset when he corrects you. ¹² For the Father's discipline comes only from his passionate love and pleasure for you. Even when it seems like his correction is harsh, It's still better than any father on earth gives to his child. ¹³ Blessings pour over the ones who find wisdom, for they have obtained living-understanding. ¹⁴ As wisdom increases, a great treasure is imparted, greater than many bars of refined gold. ¹⁵ It is a more valuable commodity than gold and gemstones, for there is nothing you desire that could compare to her. ¹⁶ Wisdom extends to you long life in one hand and wealth and promotion in the other. Out of her mouth flows righteousness, and her words release both law and mercy. ¹⁷ The ways of wisdom are sweet, always drawing you into the place of wholeness. ¹⁸ Seeking for her brings the discovery of untold blessings, for she is the healing tree of life to those who taste her fruits. ¹⁹ The Lord laid the earth's foundations with wisdom's blueprints. By his living-understanding all the universe came into being. TPT

Colossians 1 ¹⁹ For God is satisfied to have all his fullness dwelling in Christ. TPT

Isaiah 9 ⁶ A child has been born for us; a son has been given to us. The responsibility of complete dominion will rest on his shoulders, and his name will be: the Wonderful One, the Extraordinary Strategist, the Mighty God, the Father of Eternity, the Prince of Peace! ⁷ Great and vast is his dominion. He will bring immeasurable peace and prosperity. He will rule on David's throne and over David's kingdom to establish and uphold it by promoting justice and righteousness from this time forward and forevermore. The marvelous passion that the Lord Yahweh, Commander of Angel Armies, has for his people will ensure that it is finished! TPT

Note: vs 7 Or "His authority will continually expand." The Hebrew word misread, found only in this verse and in v 6, can be translated "empire," "governmental authority," or "dominion."

Proverbs 4 ¹³ So receive my correction no matter how hard it is to swallow, for wisdom will snap you back into place—her words will be invigorating life to you. ¹⁸ But the lovers of God walk on the highway of light, and their way shines brighter and brighter until the perfect day. TPT

Hebrews 6 ¹² So don't allow your hearts to grow dull or lose your enthusiasm, but follow the example of those who fully received what God has promised because of their strong faith and patient endurance. TPT

Acts 3 ¹⁶ Faith in Jesus' name has healed this man standing before you. It is the faith that comes through believing in Jesus' name that has made the crippled man walk right in front of your eyes! ¹⁹ And now you must repent and turn back to God so that your sins will be removed, and so that times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence. ²⁰ And he will send you Jesus, the Messiah, the appointed one. ²¹ For he must remain in heaven until the restoration of all things has taken place, fulfilling everything that God said long ago through his holy prophets.
