Grace *Charis* for God's grace is extended to sinful man. It signifies unmerited favor, undeserved blessing, a free gift.

John 3 ¹⁶ For here is the way God loved the world—he gave his only, unique Son as a gift. So now everyone who believes in him will never perish but experience everlasting life. TPT

Luke 11 ¹³ If imperfect parents know how to lovingly take care of their children and give them what they need, how much more will the perfect heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit's fullness when his children ask him." TPT

Glory: *chabod* (kah-vohd); Strong's #3519: Weightiness; that which is substantial or heavy; glory, honor, splendor, power, wealth, authority, magnificence, fame, dignity, riches, and excellency. The root of *chabod* is *chabad*, "to be heavy, glorious, notable," or "to be renowned." In the OT, "heaviness" represented honor and substance, while "lightness" was equated with vanity, instability, temporariness, and emptiness. *Chabod* is God's glory, not only His honor, renown, and majesty, but also His visible splendor, which filled Solomon's temple and will someday fill the Earth. (*Spirit Filled Living Bible*)

Habakkuk 2 ¹⁴ For as the waters fill the sea, the earth will be filled with an awareness of the glory of the Lord. NLT

Isaiah 60 ¹ "Rise up in splendor and be radiant, for your light has dawned, and Yahweh's glory now streams from you! ² Look carefully! Darkness blankets the earth, and thick clouds covers the nations, but Yahweh arises upon you and the brightness of his glory appears over you! TPT

John 17 ¹ This is what Jesus prayed as he looked up into heaven, "Father, the time has come. Unveil the glorious splendor of your Son so that I will magnify your glory! ² You have already given me authority over all people so that I may give the gift of eternal life to all those that you have given to me. ²² For the very glory you have given to me I have given them so that they will be joined together as one and experience the same unity that we enjoy. ^{24a} "Father, I ask that you allow everyone that you have given to me to be with me where I am! Then they will see my full glory..." TPT

Ephesians 5 ²⁷ All that he does in us is designed to make us a mature church for his pleasure, until we become a source of praise to him—glorious and radiant, beautiful and holy, without fault or flaw. TPT

²⁷ He did this to present her to himself as a glorious church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish. Instead, she will be holy and without fault. NLT

NOTE: The Greek word for "radiance" (*endoxos*) can also mean "gorgeous," "honorable," "esteemed," "splendid," "infused with glory." This is what Christ' love will do to you. The Greek text has "without any wrinkle." The Aramaic can be translated "without chips or knots." TPT

2 Corinthians 8 ⁹ You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that by his poverty he could make you rich. NLT

Deuteronomy 8 ¹⁸ Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant he confirmed to your ancestors with an oath. NLT

Galatians 3 ¹³ Yet, Christ paid the full price to set us free from the curse of the law. He absorbed the curse completely as he became a curse in our place. For it is written: "Everyone who is hung upon a tree is cursed." ¹⁴ Jesus Christ dissolved the curse from our lives, so that in him all the blessings of Abraham can be poured out upon gentiles. And now through faith we receive the promised Holy Spirit *who lives in us.* TPT

Proverbs 3 ¹⁶ Wisdom extends to you long life in one hand and wealth and promotion in the other. Out of her mouth flows righteousness, and her words release both law and mercy. TPT

1 Corinthians 1 ³⁰ God has united you with Christ Jesus. For our benefit God made him to be wisdom itself. Christ made us right with God; he made us pure and holy, and he freed us from sin. NLT

James 1 ⁵ And if anyone longs to be wise, ask God for wisdom and he will give it! He won't see your lack of wisdom as an opportunity to scold you over your failures but he will overwhelm your failures with his generous grace. ⁶ Just make sure you ask empowered by confident faith without doubting that you will receive. For the ambivalent person believes one minute and doubts the next. Being undecided makes you become like the rough seas driven and tossed by the wind. You're up one minute and tossed down the next. TPT

Romans 10 ¹⁷ So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. NKJV

You should send the crowds away to the nearby villages to buy themselves some food." ¹⁶ "They don't need to leave," Jesus responded. "You can give them something to eat." ¹⁷ They answered, "But all we have is five barley loaves and two fish." ¹⁸ "Let me have them," Jesus replied. ¹⁹ Then he had everyone sit down on the grass and he then took the five loaves and two fish. He looked up into heaven, gave thanks to God, and broke the bread into pieces. He then gave it to his disciples, who in turn gave it to the crowds. ²⁰ And everyone ate until they were satisfied, for the food was multiplied in front of their eyes! They picked up the leftovers and filled up twelve baskets full! ²¹ There were about five thousand men who were fed, in addition to many women and children! TPT
