Grace (unmerited favor, undeserved blessing), *charis* (Khar-ece); – 2 Corinthians 12:9
Strong's #5485; From the same root as *chara*, "joy," and *chairō*, "to rejoice." *Charis* for God's grace as extended to sinful man. It signifies unmerited favor, underserved blessing, a free gift.

Grace: "God's super added to our natural"

Glory: *chabod* (kah-vohd); Strong's #3519: Weightiness; that which is substantial or heavy; glory, honor, splendor, power, wealth, authority, magnificence, fame, dignity, riches, and excellency. The root of *chabod* is *chabad*, "to be heavy, glorious, notable," or "to be renowned." In the OT, "heaviness" represented honor and substance, while "lightness" was equated with vanity, instability, temporariness, and emptiness. *Chabod* is God's glory, not only His honor, renown, and majesty, but also His visible splendor, which filled Solomon's temple and will someday fill the Earth. From *chabod* are derived the names "Jochebed" ("Yahweh Is Glory") and Ichabod ("Where Is the Glory?"). (*Spirit Filled Living Bible*)

Jeremiah 29 ¹¹ For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, **thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.** NKJV

Psalms 34 ¹⁹ Many are the afflictions of the righteous: **But the LORD delivereth him out of them all.** KJV

Romans 8 ¹⁸ I am convinced that **any suffering we endure is less than nothing compared to the magnitude of glory that is about to be unveiled within us.** TPT

Psalms 139 ⁵ **You've gone into my future to prepare the way,** and in kindness you follow behind me to spare me from the harm of my past. You have laid your hand on me! ¹⁶ **You saw who you created me to be before I became me! Before I'd ever seen the light of day, the number of days you planned for me were already recorded in your book.** ¹⁷⁻¹⁸ Every single moment you are thinking of me! How precious and wonderful to consider that **you cherish me constantly in your every thought!** O God, your desires toward me are more than the grains of sand on every shore! When I awake each morning, you're still with me. TPT

Romans 8 ² For **the "law" of the Spirit of life flowing through the anointing of Jesus** has liberated us from the "law" of sin and death. TPT

John 17 ²² **For the very glory you have given to me I have given them** so that they will be joined together as one and experience the same unity that we enjoy. TPT

Philippians 1 ⁶ *I pray with great faith for you, because* **I'm fully convinced that the One who began this gracious work in you will faithfully continue the process of maturing you until the unveiling of our Lord Jesus Christ!** ⁷ It's no wonder I pray with such confidence, since you have a permanent place in my heart! You have remained partners with me in the wonderful grace of God even though I'm here in chains for standing up for the truth of the gospel. ⁸ Only God knows how much I dearly love you with the tender affection of Jesus, the Anointed One. ⁹ **I continue to pray for your love to grow and increase beyond measure, bringing you into the rich revelation of spiritual insight in all things.** ¹⁰ This will enable you to choose the most excellent way of all —**becoming pure and without offense until the unveiling of Christ.** ¹¹ And you will be filled completely with the fruits of righteousness that are found in Jesus, the Anointed One—**bringing great praise and glory to God!** TPT

2 Thessalonians 1 ³ We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other, NKJV - ³ We feel a personal responsibility to continually be thanking God for you, our spiritual family, every time we pray. And we have every reason to do so because your faith is growing marvelously beyond measure. The unselfish love each of you share for one another is increasing and overflowing! TPT

Romans 1 ¹⁶ I refuse to be ashamed of the wonderful message of God's liberating power unleashed in us through Christ! For I am thrilled to preach that everyone who believes is saved—the Jew first, and then people everywhere! ¹⁷ This gospel unveils a continual revelation of God's righteousness—a perfect righteousness given to us when we believe. And it moves us from receiving life through faith, to the power of living by faith. This is what the Scripture means when it says: "We are right with God through life-giving faith!" TPT

2 Corinthians 3 ¹⁷ Now, the "Lord" I'm referring to is the Holy Spirit, and wherever he is Lord, there is freedom. ¹⁸ We can all draw close to him with the veil removed from our faces. And with no veil we all become like mirrors who brightly reflect the glory of the Lord Jesus. We are being transfigured into his very image as we move from one brighter level of glory to another. And this glorious transfiguration comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. TPT

Ephesians 5 ²⁷ All that he does in us is designed to make us a mature church for his pleasure, until we become a source of praise to him—glorious and radiant, beautiful and holy, without fault or flaw. TPT

Ephesians 3 ¹⁰ The purpose of this was to unveil before every throne and rank of angelic orders in the heavenly realm God's full and diverse wisdom revealed through the church. ¹¹ This perfectly wise plan was destined from eternal ages and fulfilled completely in our Lord Jesus Christ, so that now ¹² we have boldness through him, and free access as kings before the Father because of our complete confidence in Christ's faithfulness. ¹³ My dear friends, I pray that you will remain strong and not be discouraged or ashamed by all that I suffer on your behalf, for it is for your glory. ¹⁴ So I kneel humbly in awe before the Father of our Lord Jesus, the Messiah, ¹⁵ the perfect Father of every father and child in heaven and on the earth. ¹⁶ And I pray that he would unveil within you the unlimited riches of his glory and favor until supernatural strength floods your innermost being with his divine might and explosive power. ¹⁷ Then, by constantly using your faith, the life of Christ will be released deep inside you, and the resting place of his love will become the very source and root of your life. ¹⁸⁻¹⁹ Then you will be empowered to discover what every holy one experiences—the great magnitude of the astonishing love of Christ in all its dimensions. How deeply intimate and far-reaching is his love! How enduring and inclusive it is! Endless love beyond measurement that transcends our understanding—this extravagant love pours into you until you are filled to overflowing with the fullness of God! ²⁰ Never doubt God's mighty power to work in you and accomplish all this. He will achieve infinitely more than your greatest request, your most unbelievable dream, and exceed your wildest imagination! He will outdo them all, for his miraculous power constantly energizes you. TPT

2 Peter 1 ⁴ As a result of this, he has given you magnificent promises that are beyond all price, so that through the power of these tremendous promises we can experience partnership with the divine nature, by which you have escaped the corrupt desires that are of the world. TPT
