Isaiah 9 ⁶ For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷ Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this. NKJV

Romans 14 ¹⁷ for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. NKJV

Matthew 6 ³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. NKJV

1 Corinthians 1 ³⁰ But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption... NKJV

Ephesians 1 ¹⁷ that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ¹⁸ the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power ²⁰ which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, ²¹ far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. ²² And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, ²³ which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all. NKJV

Ephesians 3 ¹⁰ The purpose of this was to unveil before every throne and rank of angelic orders in the heavenly realm God's full and diverse wisdom revealed through the church. ¹⁴ So I kneel humbly in awe before the Father of our Lord Jesus, the Messiah, ¹⁵ the perfect Father of every father and child in heaven and on the earth. ¹⁶ And I pray that he would unveil within you the unlimited riches of his glory and favor until supernatural strength floods your innermost being with his divine might and explosive power. ¹⁷ Then, by constantly using your faith, the life of Christ will be released deep inside you, and the resting place of his love will become the very source and root of your life. ¹⁸⁻¹⁹ Then you will be empowered to discover what every holy one experiences—the great magnitude of the astonishing love of Christ in all its dimensions. How deeply intimate and far-reaching is his love! How enduring and inclusive it is! Endless love beyond measurement that transcends our understanding—this extravagant love pours into you until you are filled to overflowing with the fullness of God! ²⁰ Never doubt God's mighty power to work in you and accomplish all this. He will achieve infinitely more than your greatest request, your most unbelievable dream, and exceed your wildest imagination! He will outdo them all, for his miraculous power constantly energizes you. TPT

Luke 4 ¹ Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, ² being tempted for forty days by the devil. And in those days He ate nothing, and afterward, when they had ended, He was hungry. ³ And the devil said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." ⁴ But Jesus answered him, saying, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.'" ⁸ And Jesus answered and said to him, "Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and

Him only you shall serve.¹² **And Jesus answered and said to him, “It has been said, ‘You shall not tempt the Lord your God.’”** NKJV

Psalm 91 ¹ He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. ² **I will say of the Lord, “He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.”** ³ **Surely He shall deliver you** from the snare of the fowler *And* from the perilous pestilence. ⁴ He shall cover you with His feathers, *And* under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth *shall be your* shield and buckler. ⁵ You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, *Nor* of the arrow *that* flies by day, ⁶ *Nor* of the pestilence *that* walks in darkness, *Nor* of the destruction *that* lays waste at noonday. ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, *And* ten thousand at your right hand; *But* it shall not come near you. ⁸ Only with your eyes shall you look, *And* see the reward of the wicked. ⁹ **Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place,** ¹⁰ **No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;** ¹¹ **For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.** ¹² In *their* hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone. ¹³ You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, The young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot. ¹⁴ **“Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation.”** NKJV

Isaiah 54 ¹³ **All your children shall be taught by the Lord, And great shall be the peace of your children.** ¹⁴ In righteousness you shall be established; **You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; And from terror, for it shall not come near you.** ¹⁵ Indeed they shall surely assemble, *but* not because of Me. Whoever assembles against you shall fall for your sake. ¹⁷ **No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me,** Says the Lord. NKJV

Isaiah 49 ²⁵ But Yahweh says: “The prey will be freed from the mighty warrior, and captives will be rescued from a conqueror! For I will fight with those who fight with you, and **I myself will save your children.** TPT

Ephesians 6 ¹² **For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.** NKJV

2 Corinthians 4 ³ But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, ⁴ **whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe,** lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. NKJV

Matthew 12 ²⁴ But when the *P'rushim* heard of it, they said, **“It is only by Ba'al-Zibbul” — the ruler of the demons** — “that this man drives out demons.” ²⁷ Besides, if I drive out demons by Ba'al-Zibbul, by whom do your people drive them out? So, they will be your judges! ²⁸ But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God has come upon you! ²⁹ **“Or again, how can someone break into a strong man's house and make off with his possessions unless he first ties up the strong man? After that he can ransack his house.** CJB

2 Chronicles 7 ¹⁴ **if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.** NKJV
