1 Thessalonians 5 ¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray without ceasing, ¹⁸ in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. NKJV

Psalm 100 ¹ Make a joyful shout to the Lord, all you lands! ² Serve the Lord with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. ³ Know that the Lord, He *is* God; *It is* He *who* has made us, and not we ourselves; *We are* His people and the sheep of His pasture. ⁴ Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. ⁵ For the Lord *is* good; His mercy *is* everlasting, And His truth *endures* to all generations. NKJV

Isaiah 54 ¹³ All your children shall be taught by the Lord, And great shall be the peace of your children. ¹⁴ In righteousness you shall be established; You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; And from terror, for it shall not come near you. ¹⁵ Indeed they shall surely assemble, *but* not because of Me. Whoever assembles against you shall fall for your sake. ¹⁷ No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me, Says the Lord. NKJV

Isaiah 49 ²⁵ But Yahweh says: "The prey will be freed from the mighty warrior, and captives will be rescued from a conqueror! For I will fight with those who fight with you, and I myself will save your children. TPT

Ephesians 6 ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. NKJV

Luke 10 ¹⁹ Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. NKJV

2 Corinthians 4 ³ But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, ⁴ whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. NKJV

Matthew 12 ²⁴ But when the *P'rushim* heard of it, they said, "It is only by Ba'al-Zibbul" — the ruler of the demons — "that this man drives out demons." ²⁷ Besides, if I drive out demons by Ba'al-Zibbul, by whom do your people drive them out? So, they will be your judges! ²⁸ But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God has come upon you! ²⁹ "Or again, how can someone break into a strong man's house and make off with his possessions unless he first ties up the strong man? After that he can ransack his house. CJB

2 Chronicles 7 ¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. NKJV

Wicked Ways: Idolatry - Immorality - Innocent Bloodshed - Broken Covenants

1 John 1 ⁹ If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. NKJV

Hosea 4 ^{6a} My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. NKJV

2 Corinthians 10 ³⁻⁴ For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, *using manipulation to achieve our aims*. Instead, our **spiritual weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses *behind which people hide*. ⁵ **We can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One.** TPT**

Philippians 4 ⁶ Don't be pulled in different directions or worried about a thing. Be saturated in prayer throughout each day, offering your faith-filled requests before God with overflowing gratitude. Tell him every detail of your life, ⁷ then God's wonderful peace that transcends human understanding, will guard your heart and mind through Jesus Christ. ⁸ Keep your thoughts continually fixed on all that is authentic and real, honorable and admirable, beautiful and respectful, pure and holy, merciful and kind. And fasten your thoughts on every glorious work of God, praising him always. TPT

Matthew 7 ⁷ "Ask, and the gift is yours. Seek, and you'll discover. Knock, and the door will be opened for you. ⁸ **For every persistent one will get what he asks for. Every persistent seeker will discover what he longs for. And everyone who knocks persistently will one day find an open door.** TPT

Hebrews 6 ¹² So don't allow your hearts to grow dull or lose your enthusiasm, but follow the example of those who fully received what God has promised because of their *strong faith*** and ***patient endurance***.** TPT

Romans 4 ³ Listen to what the Scriptures say: Because Abraham believed God's words, his faith transferred God's righteousness into his account. ¹⁷ That's what the Scripture means when it says: "I have made you the father of many nations." **He is our example and father,** for in God's presence he believed that God can raise the dead and call into being things that don't even exist yet. ¹⁸ **Against all odds, when it looked hopeless, Abraham believed the promise and expected God to fulfill it. He took God at his word,** and as a result he became the father of many nations. God's declaration over him came to pass: "Your descendants will be so many that they will be impossible to count!" ¹⁹ In spite of being nearly one hundred years old when the promise of having a son was made, his faith was so strong that it could not be undermined by the fact that he and Sarah were incapable of conceiving a child. ²⁰⁻²¹ **He never stopped believing God's promise,** for he was made strong in his faith *to father a child*. And **because he was mighty in faith and convinced that God had all the power needed to fulfill his promises, Abraham glorified God!** TPT

Galatians 3 ⁶ Abraham, *our father of faith*, believed God, and the substance of his faith released God's righteousness to him. ⁷ So the true children of Abraham have the same faith as their father! ⁹ **And so the blessing of Abraham's faith is now our blessing too! ¹³ **Yet, Christ paid the full price to set us free from the curse of the law. He absorbed the curse completely as he became a curse in our place.** For it is written: "Everyone who is hung upon a tree is cursed." ¹⁴ **Jesus Christ dissolved the curse from our lives, so that in him all the blessings of Abraham can be poured out upon gentiles.** And now through faith we receive the promised Holy Spirit *who lives in us*. ²⁶ **You have all become true children of God by faith in Jesus Christ!** ²⁹ **And if you belong to Christ, then you are now Abraham's "child" and a true heir of all his blessings because of the promise God made to Abraham!** TPT (See Deuteronomy 28)**
