Ephesians 1 ⁵⁻⁶ For it was always in his perfect plan to adopt us as his delightful children, through our union with Jesus, the Anointed One, so that his tremendous love that cascades over us would glorify his grace—for the same love he has for the Beloved, Jesus, he has for us. And this unfolding plan brings him great pleasure! ⁷ Since we are now joined to Christ, we have been given the treasures of redemption by his blood—the total cancellation of our sins—all because of the cascading riches of his grace. ⁸ This *superabundant* grace is already powerfully working in us, releasing all forms of wisdom and practical understanding. ⁹ And through the revelation of the Anointed One, he unveiled his secret desires to us—the hidden mystery of his long-range plan, which he was delighted to implement from the very beginning of time. ¹⁰ And because of God's unfailing purpose, this detailed plan will reign supreme through every period of time until the fulfillment of all the ages finally reaches its climax—when God makes all things new in all of heaven and earth through Jesus Christ. ¹¹ Through our union with Christ we too have been claimed by God as his own inheritance. Before we were even born, he gave us our destiny; that we would fulfill the plan of God who always accomplishes every purpose and plan in his heart. TPT

John 3 ¹⁵ so that those who truly believe in him will not perish but be given eternal life. ¹⁶ For here is the way God loved the world—he gave his only, unique Son as a gift. So now everyone who believes in him will never perish but experience everlasting life. ¹⁷ “God did not send his Son into the world to judge and condemn the world, but to be its Savior and rescue it! ¹⁸ So now there is no longer any condemnation for those who believe in him, but the unbeliever already lives under condemnation because they do not believe in the name of the only Son of God. TPT

1 John 5 ¹¹ This is the true testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life has its source in his Son. ¹² Whoever has the Son has *eternal* life; whoever does not have the Son does not possess *eternal* life. ¹³ I've written this letter to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you will be assured and know without a doubt that you have eternal life. TPT

1 John 4 ¹⁷ By *living in God*, love has been brought to its full expression in us so that we may fearlessly face the day of judgment, because all that Jesus now is, so are we in this world. TPT

1 Corinthians 1 ³⁰ But *it is* due to Him *that* you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption... NASB 2020

Romans 5 ¹⁷ Death once held us in its grip, and by the blunder of one man, death reigned as king over humanity. But now, how much more are we held in the grip of grace and continue reigning as kings in life, enjoying our regal freedom through the gift of perfect righteousness in the one and only Jesus, the Messiah! ¹⁸ In other words, just as condemnation came upon all people through one transgression, so through one righteous act of *Jesus' sacrifice*, the perfect righteousness that makes us right with God and leads us to a victorious life is now available to all. TPT

Proverbs 3 ¹³ Blessed is a person who finds wisdom, And one who obtains understanding. ¹⁴ For her profit is better than the profit of silver, And her produce better than gold. ¹⁵ She is more precious than jewels, And nothing you desire compares with her. ¹⁶ Long life is in her right hand; In her left hand are riches and honor. NASB 2020

John 17 ²² For the very glory you have given to me I have given them so that they will be joined together as one and experience the same unity that we enjoy. ²³ You live fully in me and now I live fully in them so that they will experience perfect unity, and the world will be convinced that you have sent

me, for they will see that you love each one of them with the same passionate love that you have for me. TPT

2 Corinthians 8 ⁹ For you have experienced the extravagant grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that although he was infinitely rich, he impoverished himself for our sake, so that by his poverty, we become rich beyond measure. TPT

Deuteronomy 8 ¹⁸ But you are to remember the Lord your God, for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth, in order to confirm His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. NASB 2020

Galatians 3 ²⁹ And if you belong to Christ, then you are now Abraham's "child" and a true heir of all his blessings because of the promise God made to Abraham! TPT

Proverbs 10 ²² It is the blessing of the Lord that makes rich, And He adds no sorrow to it. NASB2020

Proverbs 13 ^{22a} good person leaves an inheritance to his grandchildren, And the wealth of a sinner is stored up for the righteous. NASB2020

Genesis 12 ² Follow me, and I will make you into a great nation. I will exceedingly bless and prosper you, and I will make you famous, so that you will be a tremendous source of blessing for others. ³ I will bless all who bless you and curse all who curse you. And through you all the families of the earth will be blessed." TPT

Genesis 13 ² Now Abram was very rich in livestock, silver, and gold. NASB2020

Genesis 26 ^{1a} Now there was a famine in the land, besides the previous famine that had occurred in the days of Abraham... ² And the Lord appeared to him and said, "Do not go down to Egypt; stay in the land of which I shall tell you. ³ Live for a time in this land and I will be with you and bless you, for to you and to your descendants I will give all these lands, and I will establish the oath which I swore to your father Abraham. ⁴ I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven, and will give your descendants all these lands; and by your descendants all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, ⁵ because Abraham obeyed Me and fulfilled his duty to Me, and kept My commandments, My statutes, and My laws." ... ¹² Now Isaac sowed in that land and reaped in the same year a hundred times as much. And the Lord blessed him, ¹³ and the man became rich, and continued to grow richer until he became very wealthy; ¹⁴ for he had possessions of flocks and herds, and a great household, so that the Philistines envied him. NASB2020

Psalms 112 ¹ Praise the Lord! Blessed is a person who fears the Lord, Who greatly delights in His commandments. ² His descendants will be mighty on the earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed. ³ Wealth and riches are in his house, And his righteousness endures forever. ... ⁷ He will not fear bad news; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord. ⁸ His heart is firm, he will not fear, But will look with satisfaction on his enemies. ⁹ He has given freely to the poor, His righteousness endures forever; His horn will be exalted in honor. NASB2020

Isaiah 53 ³ He was despised and abandoned by men, A man of great pain and familiar with sickness; And like one from whom people hide their faces, He was despised, and we had no regard for Him. ⁴ However, it was our sicknesses that He Himself bore, And our pains that He carried; Yet we ourselves assumed that He had been afflicted, Struck down by God, and humiliated. ⁵ But He was pierced for our offenses, He was crushed for our wrongdoings; The punishment for our well-being was laid upon Him, And by His wounds we are healed. NASB2020

1 Peter 2 ²⁴ He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed. NLT
