God's Power in Creation

Genesis 1 ¹⁻³ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. And the earth was a formless and desolate emptiness, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. NASB

Jeremiah 32 ¹⁷ Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You. ESV

John 1 ¹⁻³ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. NKJV

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Jeremiah 32 ²⁷ Behold, I am **YAHWEH**, God of all the world. Nothing is impossible with me. TPT

Luke 1 ³⁷ For with God nothing will be impossible." NKJV

We need to be an advertisement of God's Power!

Ephesians 1 ¹⁹⁻²⁰ I pray that you will continually experience the immeasurable greatness of God's power made available to you through faith. Then your lives will be an advertisement of this immense power as it works through you! This is the mighty power that was released when God raised Christ from the dead and exalted him to the place of highest honor and supreme authority in the heavenly realm! TPT

Isaiah 40 ²⁸⁻³¹ Don't you know? Haven't you been listening? Yahweh is the one and only everlasting God, the Creator of all you can see and imagine! He never gets weary or worn out. His intelligence is unlimited; he is never puzzled over what to do! He empowers the feeble and infuses the powerless with increasing strength. Even young people faint and get exhausted... But those who wait for Yahweh's grace will experience divine strength. They will rise up on soaring wings and fly like eagles, run their race without growing weary, and **walk through life without giving up**. TPT

God's Limitless Power Working in us

2 Corinthians 4 ⁷⁻¹⁰ We are like common clay jars that carry this glorious treasure within, so that this immeasurable power will be seen as God's, not ours. Though we experience every kind of pressure, we're not crushed. At times we don't know what to do, but quitting is not an option. We are persecuted by others, but God has not forsaken us. We may be knocked down, but not out. TPT

2 Corinthians 12 ⁹ My grace is sufficient for you [My lovingkindness and My mercy are more than enough—always available—regardless of the situation]; for [My] power is being perfected [and is completed and shows itself most effectively] in [your] weakness. AMP

Psalms 78 ⁴¹⁻⁴² Yes, again and again they tempted God, And limited the Holy One of Israel. They did not remember His power: The day when He redeemed them from the enemy... NKJV

Luke 10 ¹⁹ Behold, I have given you authority (exousia) to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you. ESV

Strong's Greek #1849 Exousia = authority, jurisdiction, liberty, power, right, and strength.

God's Power in His Plans and Promises for us

Jeremiah 29 ¹¹ For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. ESV/NLT

Psalms 27 ¹⁴ Here's what I've learned through it all: Don't give up; don't be impatient; be entwined as one with the Lord. Be brave and courageous, and never lose hope. TPT

Isaiah 55 ⁸ For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD. ESV

Hebrews 10 ²³ Let us seize *and* hold tightly the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is reliable *and* trustworthy *and* faithful [to His word] AMP

Lamentations 3 ²²⁻²³ The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. ESV

Jeremiah 33 ³ Call to me and I will answer you and tell you [and even show you] great and mighty things, [things which have been confined and hidden], which you do not know and understand and cannot distinguish. AMP

Isaiah 54 ² Enlarge (make room, make open wide) the place of your tent, and let the curtains of your habitations be stretched out; do not hold back; lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes. ESV

1 Corinthians 2 ⁹ "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him." NLT
