



HAPN-GAPN 86-Day Prayer Guide for President Trump 2025-2026

Before President Donald Trump became President of the United States for the second time, his life was spared in an assassination attempt that fell short by the grace and mercy of God. It wasn't widely known, but there were at least 8 attempts during his first administration that were foiled, discovered, or disrupted. Since taking office in January of this year, there have been many intercessors, prophets, and apostolic voices that have had dreams, visions, and promptings regarding the President's safety. Many have seen his life in danger and have begun to pray regarding attempts to poison him, snipers trying to take him out, and even inside corrupt individuals seeking his demise. I do not doubt that what is being "seen" is heaven alerting us and sounding an alarm.

This is why I believe we need a more ongoing approach to keep a hedge of protection around our President. The following prayer guide is an 86-day quick guide to spark prayer for President Trump on a daily basis. This is just a starting point and not meant to be the full extent of our covering of the Commander in Chief. However, it is definitely tinder for the fire and a great springboard beginning point for all of us. It also facilitates a unified focus where thousands, and hundreds of thousands of people will be praying the same thing on the same day empowering a concert of intercession throughout the nation and around the world for the President. As most of us know, President Trump and his family, and any others aligned with or supporting him, are being cursed, hexed, mocked, and constantly berated. Sadly, many Christians have bought into the propaganda and lies that are rampant on social media and the liberal media. They speak out against him with great bitterness and vitriol. This must change. The mean-spirited, judgmental arguments must be countered with our Spirit-filled intercession. President Trump needs us to pray. And God needs us to ask Him how to pray, so that we are declaring what He desires to do in our President, the nation and the nations of the world, not just what we want. I pray this guide ignites us, prompts us, and wakes us to be more alert watchmen on the wall.

In conjunction with this guide, I would encourage each of us to pray the following five Protection Prayers over the President every day, then pray in tongues for five minutes. If God prompts you to pray more, or if you receive additional revelation to pray, wonderful!

Daily Protection Prayers

1. *Deuteronomy 31:6* – “Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the LORD your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.” God keep President Trump out of fear or dread of men. Let him know You go with him and You will not leave or forsake him. May he walk in the fear of the Lord.
2. *Psalms 32:7* – “You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with shouts of deliverance.” Father, thank You for helping President Trump know that You are a hiding place for him, that You preserve him from trouble, and you surround him with shouts of deliverance.
3. *Proverbs 2:7-8* – “He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; he is a shield to those who walk in integrity, guarding the paths of justice and watching over the way of his saints.” God we thank You for giving President Trump sound wisdom and guarding the paths of justice he walks on. We call him into a deeper relationship with You as You shield him from attack.
4. *Isaiah 54:17* – “No weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed, and you shall refute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and their vindication from me, declares the Lord.” No gun, knife, or bomb...no poison, sword, or snare...no terrorist, deep state, liberal, globalist weapon...no evil word, occult curse, spell or conjuring...no wicked intent, murderous plot, or satanic scheme will succeed against President Donald J. Trump. He is highly favored, guarded by the angelic host, and protected by the presence of God. You are a shield about him.
5. *Psalms 34:7* – “The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them.” We thank You, Lord for guarding and protecting President Trump. We bless the angel of the Lord encamped around him at all times. His holy entourage never sleeps, never rests, and are always on the alert.

Day 1 - November 11, 2025

 **Psalm 91:2 (NASB)** – *“I will say to the Lord, ‘My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!’”*

 We pray that when fear rises, President Trump will speak faith out loud. God, You’re not only his shelter from the storm—You are his strength within it.

Day 2 - November 12, 2025

 **Isaiah 40:31 (NASB)** – *“Yet those who wait for the Lord will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles.”*

 Waiting on You, God is not wasting time—it’s strengthening our souls. May President Trump rest in You and rise renewed above every obstacle today. We bless our President to reject impulsiveness and embrace patiently waiting, to hear Your prompt as You undergird and bring instruction to him.

Day 3 - November 13, 2025

 **Proverbs 3:5–6 (NASB)** – *“Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.”*

 President Trump may not see every turn ahead, but God, Your guidance is sure. When he surrenders control, Your peace becomes his compass, and his plumbline.

Day 4 - November 14, 2025

Day 8 - November 18, 2025

Day 13 - November 23, 2025

Day 29 - December 9, 2025
